Global Watch Daily – November 21, 2025

Israel & Jerusalem

In a disturbing development, an anonymous website has reportedly offered a bounty of \$100,000 for the assassination of top Israeli research academics, raising concerns about targeted violence against Israel’s intellectual community ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, the European Union has increased its financial support to the Palestinian Authority, linking aid to reforms aimed at rebuilding Gaza, signaling international efforts to stabilize the region following recent conflicts ([Times of Israel](#)). However, the situation remains tense as a crowd outside a New York City synagogue chanted death threats, highlighting ongoing antisemitism and communal tensions abroad ([Times of Israel](#)).

Protesters chanting “Death to the IDF” have drawn attention to the volatile atmosphere surrounding Israel’s military actions. At the same time, some commentators have questioned the appropriateness of certain synagogue events amidst these tensions ([Israel365 News](#)). In France, efforts to combat antisemitism took a symbolic turn with the promotion of Alfred Dreyfus’s legacy 130 years after his wrongful conviction, though debate continues over whether such gestures are sufficient ([Israel365 News](#)). Additionally, a new study has revived interest in the biblical landscape of the Carmel Plain, once filled with migratory birds, connecting modern research with ancient scriptural contexts ([Israel365 News](#)).

The reconstruction of Gaza remains a complex challenge, with detailed planning needed to address the region’s infrastructure and humanitarian needs ([JNS](#)). The city of Netanya is mourning the loss of its longtime mayor, Miriam Feirberg-Ikar, whose leadership was widely respected ([JNS](#)). On a global scale, mayors from around the world gathered in Paris to discuss strategies to combat rising antisemitism, reflecting international concern over this persistent issue ([JNS](#)).

In regional security news, the Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) issued an evacuation order for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, signaling heightened military alertness ([Jerusalem Post](#)). The Israeli Defense Ministry also announced a military exercise on Highway 35, scheduled



for Sunday afternoon, aimed at readiness and strategic positioning ([Jerusalem Post](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Israeli Prime Minister and senior officials recently visited the buffer zone in southern Syria, a region critical to Israel's security, as diplomatic talks between Israel and Syria have stalled with no immediate resolution in sight ([Long War Journal](#)). Hamas has publicly rejected a United Nations Security Council vote that endorsed key aspects of a 20-point plan for Gaza, maintaining its opposition to international proposals for the region's governance and reconstruction ([Long War Journal](#)).

Israeli military operations against Hezbollah in Lebanon have continued, with detailed reports covering activities from November 10 to 16, 2025, underscoring ongoing tensions along Israel's northern border ([Long War Journal](#)). Meanwhile, Iran faces increasing internal and external pressures, with analysts comparing its current challenges to the collapse of the Soviet Union, suggesting a potential reckoning for the regime ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)). The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) recently passed a resolution demanding detailed information on the status of Iranian nuclear sites and its stockpile of enriched uranium, reflecting global concerns about nuclear proliferation ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

The Syrian government condemned the Israeli Prime Minister's visit to troops in southern Syria, viewing it as a provocative act amid the fragile regional dynamics ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

Apostasy & Religious Developments

Pastors and church leaders have expressed concern over viral warnings about planned Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) raids on churches, which have caused unease within religious communities about potential government actions ([Religion News Service](#)). In Texas, a Muslim civil rights group has filed a lawsuit against the state governor following accusations labeling the group as terrorists, highlighting ongoing religious and political tensions ([Religion News Service](#)).

In cultural developments, the current number one Christian music artist has been noted for lacking a traditional soulfulness in their work, sparking discussions about contemporary Christian music trends ([Christianity Today](#)). Meanwhile, a revival event hosted by UniteUS at Clemson University attracted 6,000 students, demonstrating significant youth



engagement with the Christian faith and spiritual renewal ([Crosswalk](#)).

Reports from the persecuted church include the story of a woman who found refuge in an orphanage after being rescued from captivity by the Allied Democratic Forces (ADF), a militant group in Central Africa ([International Christian Concern](#)). Nigerian Christian leaders have also called for U.S. intervention as atrocities against believers reportedly worsen in the region ([International Christian Concern](#)). Additionally, in the Democratic Republic of Congo, the government and the M23 rebel group have agreed on an initial peace framework, offering a potential path toward stability ([International Christian Concern](#)).

Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering

Recent scientific advances include the development of a tiny microneedle patch that significantly improves recovery following heart attacks, representing a promising innovation in medical treatment ([Science Daily](#)). Researchers have also successfully grown a miniature human “blood factory” that functions effectively, potentially revolutionizing blood supply and transfusion medicine ([Science Daily](#)).

In the realm of pharmaceutical development, artificial intelligence has been employed to optimize the extraction of biologically active compounds from *Phylloporia ribis*, enhancing the efficacy of natural products ([Nature](#)). Additionally, new methodologies for monitoring glycosylated subunit vaccines have been introduced, improving vaccine quality control ([Nature](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Scientists have uncovered a tiny ancient virus that reveals secrets potentially valuable for combating antibiotic-resistant superbugs, offering hope for new antimicrobial strategies ([Science Daily](#)). Meanwhile, strange microscopic structures have been identified in the blood of Long COVID patients, helping to understand this complex post-viral condition ([Science Daily](#)).

Historical research has clarified misconceptions about the Black Death, revealing how a 14th-century story misled the world about the nature of the plague ([Science Daily](#)). The European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control has released its annual epidemiological report on zoonotic influenza for 2023, providing data critical for monitoring and preventing outbreaks ([ECDC](#)).



Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

The Ibu Volcano recently erupted, with the latest volcanic ash advisory issued on November 21, 2025, indicating ongoing volcanic activity that may affect nearby populations and air travel ([Volcano Discovery](#)). Earthquake activity has also been recorded in California, including a magnitude 2.0 quake near Guerneville and more minor tremors near The Geysers geothermal area, reflecting continued seismic activity in the region ([USGS](#)).

NASA's Hubble Space Telescope is currently seeking star clusters in a so-called "lost galaxy," aiming to deepen understanding of galactic formation and evolution ([NASA](#)). Additionally, the Europa Clipper spacecraft has captured images of Uranus using its star tracker camera, contributing to planetary science and exploration ([NASA](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

Former U.S. President Donald Trump has released a new peace plan aimed at resolving the Russia-Ukraine conflict, outlining proposals for a ceasefire and negotiations ([Politico](#)). Ahead of Sweden's 2026 elections, authorities are preparing for potential cyberattacks targeting the electoral process, reflecting concerns about election security in the digital age ([Politico](#)).

In Serbia, President Aleksandar Vučić has denied allegations linking him to "sniper tourism" during the Sarajevo siege, rejecting accusations that have stirred controversy in the region ([Politico](#)). Egyptian students studying in Russia report pressure to either join the Russian army or leave the country, highlighting the geopolitical strains affecting international students ([France24](#)).

The European Union continues to push for reforms within the Palestinian Authority as part of efforts to establish a path to stability and help end the Gaza war ([France24](#)). In a lighter but notable event, soccer star Cristiano Ronaldo attended a meeting and dinner with Donald Trump at the White House, drawing public attention ([France24](#)).

Britain has uncovered a money-laundering network that has been funding Russia's war efforts in Ukraine, part of broader international efforts to disrupt financial support for the conflict ([France24](#)). In Nigeria, pupils were abducted from a Catholic school in a fresh attack, continuing a troubling pattern of violence against Christians in the region ([BBC](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts



Archaeologists have uncovered an Assyrian inscription dating back to the First Temple period, providing valuable insights into the history of ancient Israel ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)). In the same area, the largest dam from ancient Israel was recently uncovered, shedding light on the engineering capabilities of biblical-era societies ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)).

A rare gold coin belonging to Egyptian Queen Berenice II was discovered in the City of David, highlighting the region's historical connections with neighboring civilizations ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)). Additionally, a rare coin from the Year Four Revolt was found in Jerusalem, offering tangible evidence of the city's tumultuous history during periods of rebellion ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)).
