### **Israel & Jerusalem**

In the ongoing geopolitical landscape surrounding Israel, the United States is considering imposing sanctions on the Muslim Brotherhood, while explicitly excluding its allies, Turkey and Qatar, from these measures ([Times of Israel](#)). Argentina has nominated Rafael Grossi, the current chief of the International Atomic Energy Agency, for the position of United Nations Secretary-General, signaling a potential shift in international diplomatic leadership ([Times of Israel](#)).

The father of the last Israeli hostage killed in Gaza expressed a heartfelt prayer that his son will not become another case like Ron Arad, the Israeli airman who disappeared decades ago, underscoring the ongoing human cost of the conflict ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, the Israeli Air Force is providing aerial cover for ground forces operating near Jenin as part of ongoing security operations in the West Bank ([JNS](#)).

In a cultural and historical note, Israel365 News highlighted the biblical roots of the American Thanksgiving holiday, tracing its origins to Israel's influence and heritage ([Israel365 News](#)). Additionally, the United States has decided not to supply F-35 fighter jets to Saudi Arabia, reflecting ongoing strategic considerations in the region ([Israel365 News](#)). The Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) have issued an evacuation order for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, indicating heightened tensions and potential military actions targeting Iran ([Jerusalem Post](#)).

### **Wars & Security (Israel and Region)**

The assassination of Hezbollah's top military commander has prompted analysis of likely successors, as the group faces ongoing pressure from Israeli operations. Israeli forces continue to conduct operations against Hezbollah in Lebanon, with a series of strikes reported between November 17 and 23, 2025, aimed at degrading the

In Gaza, Hamas has handed over the body of a hostage to Israeli authorities amidst ongoing clashes, while the IDF is actively engaging terror cells in Rafah, seeking to dismantle militant networks in the southern Gaza Strip ([Long War Journal](#)). Additionally, Greece is hosting joint military exercises with Israel, Cyprus, and the United Arab Emirates, reflecting growing regional security cooperation among these nations ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

## **Apostasy & Religious Developments**

## **Pestilence & Global Health**

Scientists studying ancient viruses have uncovered a tiny virus that reveals secrets potentially valuable for combating modern superbugs, highlighting the value of historical biological research ([ScienceDaily](#)). In addition, strange microscopic structures have been found in the blood of Long COVID patients, offering new insights into the persistent symptoms many experience ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Historical research has also clarified misconceptions about the Black Death, revealing how a 14th-century story misled the world regarding the pandemic's nature and spread ([ScienceDaily](#)). ## **Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens**

On November 27, 2025, multiple seismic events were recorded globally, including a magnitude 4.9 earthquake southeast of Sarangani, Philippines, as well as minor tremors in California near Holtville and The Geysers ([Volcano Discovery](#), [USGS](#), [USGS](#), [USGS](#)).

Volcanic activity remains notable with eruptions and ash advisories issued for several volcanoes, including Fuego, Popocatépetl, Merapi, Semeru, Shiveluch, Ibu, Marapi, and Kerinci. The Shiveluch volcano in Russia has a volcanic ash advisory extending up to 22,000 feet, indicating possible eruption activity on November 27, 2025 ([Volcano Discovery](#), [Volcano Discovery](#)).

In space exploration, NASA astronaut Chris Williams and his crewmates have arrived at the International Space Station, advancing human presence in orbit ([NASA](#)). ## **Global Macro & Geopolitics**

In global political developments, North Korea has mandated the teaching of the Russian language in its schools, reflecting closer ties with Russia and shifting geopolitical alignments ([Politico](#)). ## **Middle Eastern Artifacts**

Archaeological discoveries continue to shed light on the ancient history of Jerusalem and the surrounding region.
