



Global Watch Daily – December 2, 2025

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Israel & Jerusalem

Germany has taken a significant step in international justice by sending a Libyan individual suspected of war crimes to face trial at the International Criminal Court (ICC), underscoring ongoing efforts to hold perpetrators accountable for atrocities ([Times of Israel](#)). The Israeli Prime Minister has been invited to the White House for an unprecedented fifth time, reflecting the continuing close diplomatic ties and strategic discussions between Israel and the United States ([Times of Israel](#)).

In a border town of Israel, the mayor has taken a firm stance against terror, refusing to let violence disrupt the community's resilience and daily life ([Times of Israel](#)). Recently, an alert resident prevented a major terror attack in Ateret, where two soldiers were wounded in a stabbing incident, highlighting the ongoing security challenges faced by Israel ([Israel365 News](#)).

Israel has issued warnings regarding Hezbollah's rapid efforts to rebuild its military capabilities in Lebanon, signaling concerns over regional security and the potential for renewed hostilities ([JNS](#)). Additionally, Israel is preparing to receive possible remains of hostages from Gaza for forensic testing, a somber development in the ongoing conflict and humanitarian crisis ([Al-Monitor](#)).

In other troubling developments, a monument dedicated to a slain Jewish child at a synagogue in Rome was defaced, an act that has drawn condemnation and concern for rising antisemitism ([JNS](#)). Meanwhile, an Israeli-Russian woman has reported being tortured by Iraqi militants during captivity, revealing the harsh realities faced by individuals caught in regional conflicts ([BBC News](#)). The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) have issued an evacuation order for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, indicating escalating tensions in the region ([Jerusalem Post](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)



Israel's military operations continue to target hostile networks in the region, as demonstrated by a recent raid in Beit Jinn that exposed potential Hamas-linked cells operating in southern Syria ([Long War Journal](#)). In northern Iraq, the vital Khor Mor gas field was attacked, reflecting ongoing instability and threats to critical infrastructure in the Kurdistan region ([Long War Journal](#)).

Hezbollah is undergoing a process of regeneration following the targeted killing of its leader, Hashem Safieddine, by Israel, a development that may impact the group's future operations and regional dynamics ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)). Meanwhile, Venezuela's President Maduro has solidified his position as a persistent adversary to Washington in the Western Hemisphere, maintaining a stance that complicates U.S. foreign policy in the region ([Long War Journal](#)).

In the broader security context, the DC National Guard shooting incident highlights ongoing concerns about jihadist threats within the Indian subcontinent, emphasizing the global nature of security challenges ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)). Additionally, peace talks regarding Ukraine remain stalled amid maximalist demands from Russia, prolonging the conflict and instability in Eastern Europe ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

Apostasy & Religious Developments

Pope Leo XIV has been actively engaged in Lebanon, visiting a psychiatric hospital to combat the stigma surrounding mental health in a country struggling with crisis and conflict ([Religion News Service](#)). During his visit, he also urged Lebanon's youth to remain in the country and participate in rebuilding efforts despite ongoing difficulties ([Religion News Service](#)).

In the United States, a cultural shift is noted among younger generations as some are choosing to trade time spent on social media platforms like TikTok for deeper engagement with God and community, reflecting a growing desire for spiritual connection ([Christianity Today](#)). Meanwhile, the legacy of Dorothy Day continues to challenge the church through her grandchildren's reflections, encouraging renewed focus on social justice and faithfulness ([Religion News Service](#)).

Reports from persecution watchdogs indicate ongoing challenges for believers worldwide. A Chinese pastor was released after 12 years of imprisonment, highlighting both the cost of faith and the hope of freedom ([Open Doors](#)). In Vietnam, a Thai appeals court upheld



the decision to extradite a Christian activist, underscoring the risks faced by believers in hostile environments ([Open Doors](#)).

Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering

New scientific research has identified a previously hidden organism responsible for toxic algal blooms in Lake Erie. This discovery may help manage environmental and public health risks associated with water quality ([Science Daily](#)). Additionally, doctors are observing more aggressive forms of breast cancer in younger women than previously expected, raising concerns about early detection and treatment strategies ([Science Daily](#)).

Scientists have also discovered a hidden molecular switch that allows cancer cells to survive, a finding that could lead to new therapeutic approaches to combat cancer's resilience ([Science Daily](#)). In agricultural genetics, the complete chloroplast genome of *Secale strictum* ssp. *strictum* has been sequenced, providing insights into the evolution and breeding of Triticeae species, which include essential cereal crops ([Nature](#)).

In the field of medical policy, the chair of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recently left for a new position at the Department of Health and Human Services just days before a key meeting. This change may influence vaccine recommendations ([STAT News](#)). Expert reviews have found that delaying the hepatitis B vaccine birth dose would likely increase the incidence of chronic hepatitis B infection in children, supporting current immunization schedules ([STAT News](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Scientists are increasingly concerned about the surprising heat tolerance of bird flu viruses, which could facilitate wider spread and increase the risk of human exposure ([Science Daily](#)). Stunning new three-dimensional images have revealed the hidden structure of the yellow fever virus, advancing understanding that may aid vaccine and treatment development ([Science Daily](#)).

Research into ancient viruses has uncovered tiny viral forms that could provide clues to combating modern superbugs, highlighting the ongoing importance of virology in public health ([Science Daily](#)). The European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) reports widespread avian influenza among birds, which increases the risk of zoonotic transmission to humans and calls for vigilance ([ECDC](#)).



Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

On December 2, 2025, multiple earthquakes were recorded globally, including a magnitude 1.5 quake 79 kilometers east-northeast of Tonopah, Nevada, and a magnitude 1.1 quake near Big Bear Lake, California, reflecting ongoing seismic activity in various regions ([USGS](#)) ([USGS](#)). Additionally, a magnitude 4.7 earthquake occurred 175 kilometers northeast of Lospalos, Timor Leste ([USGS](#)).

The Fuego volcano has issued a volcanic ash advisory with emissions reaching up to 16,000 feet, indicating active volcanic activity in the region ([Volcano Discovery](#)). Other volcanoes such as Santiaguito, Popocatépetl, Soputan, Merapi, Semeru, Lokon-Empung, and Karangetang are also active, demonstrating ongoing geological activity worldwide ([Volcano Discovery](#)).

In space exploration, the International Space Station (ISS) marked 25 years of continuous human presence in orbit, a milestone in human achievement and scientific research ([NASA](#)). Meanwhile, NASA has provided educational resources explaining artificial intelligence for younger audiences, reflecting the growing importance of technology literacy ([NASA](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

In Bulgaria, the government withdrew its budget proposal following the largest protests in a decade, signaling significant public discontent and political instability ([Politico](#)) ([BBC News](#)). Poland has warned the European Union not to sign weak climate agreements at future COP summits, emphasizing the need for more substantial environmental commitments ([Politico](#)).

High-level diplomatic talks are underway as Steve Witkoff arrived in Moscow for critical discussions with Vladimir Putin, focusing on geopolitical tensions and potential resolutions ([Politico](#)).
