



Global Watch Daily – December 7, 2025

A concise summary of major developments in Israel and the world through a grounded Christian worldview.

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Israel & Jerusalem

Turkish and Egyptian foreign ministers have accused Israel of breaching the ceasefire agreement daily, calling on the United States to intervene and enforce compliance ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, Hamas has publicly rejected the Trump peace plan, vowing to retain its weapons and continue its war against Israel ([Israel365 News](#)). In a related development, Israeli Prime Minister has announced plans to meet with former President Trump to discuss the second phase of the Gaza plan, indicating ongoing diplomatic efforts ([Al-Monitor](#)).

In Jerusalem, German Chancellor Merz reaffirmed Germany's support for Israel during a recent visit, emphasizing the importance of the bilateral relationship ([Al-Monitor](#)). The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) issued an evacuation order for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, signaling heightened military tensions in the region ([Jerusalem Post](#)). Additionally, the Israeli Defense Ministry announced it will conduct a military exercise on Highway 35, reflecting ongoing preparedness measures ([Jerusalem Post](#)).

On the cultural front, the grandchildren of a celebrated Israeli painter showcased their work in an exhibit held in Eilat, continuing a family legacy of artistic contribution ([Times of Israel](#)). Bethlehem illuminated its Christmas tree for the first time since the Gaza war began, symbolizing a moment of light amid conflict ([BBC News](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The conflict in Gaza continues to claim lives, with the leader of an anti-Hamas Popular Forces militia killed in the region, underscoring the ongoing violence ([Long War Journal](#)). Tensions between Israel and Syria remain high following an Israeli raid, while the White House has urged dialogue to de-escalate the situation ([Long War Journal](#)).

In Yemen, the Southern Transitional Council has seized key areas of the Hadramawt Governorate from rival government forces, illustrating the fragmented nature of the



conflict there ([Long War Journal](#)). Germany has deployed the first Israeli Arrow 3 missile defense system, a move seen as a strategic measure amid Russian military activities ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

Public opinion in the United States shows significant support for military action, with a new survey revealing that 60 percent of Americans approve of U.S. strikes against Iranian nuclear facilities ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)). Meanwhile, Russian President Vladimir Putin has reasserted claims on the entire Donbas region of Ukraine, calling for the liberation of these territories by force, which continues to fuel conflict in Eastern Europe ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

Apostasy & Religious Developments

Religious communities worldwide are experiencing notable developments. In Sudan, several churches have been vandalized, highlighting the ongoing persecution of Christians in the region ([International Christian Concern](#)). Communist nations continue to persecute believers through intense scrutiny and bureaucratic red tape, restricting Christian practice and witness ([International Christian Concern](#)).

In the Democratic Republic of Congo and Rwanda, leaders have reaffirmed their intentions for peace amid ongoing violence in eastern DRC, signaling efforts to stabilize the region ([International Christian Concern](#)). Meanwhile, in the United States, Catholic campus ministers are working toward culturally responsive ministry for Latino students, fostering a welcoming environment for diverse believers ([Religion News Service](#)).

Youth ministry strategies are being developed to engage families through sports, recognizing the importance of holistic outreach to younger generations ([The Gospel Coalition](#)). Additionally, the popular Bible app YouVersion has revealed that Bible reading has hit record levels in 2025, with the most popular verse reflecting a renewed interest in Scripture ([Crosswalk](#)).

Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering

Recent scientific advances include the discovery of a rotten-egg-smelling compound that shows promise for effectively treating nail fungus, offering a new approach to a common condition ([ScienceDaily](#)). Researchers have also identified a natural hormone that activates a hidden fat-burning switch, potentially contributing to obesity treatments ([ScienceDaily](#)).



In the field of genetic engineering, scientists have developed a CRISPR-free RNA base editing technique that restores hearing in mice with a specific genetic mutation, marking a significant step forward in gene therapy ([Nature Communications](#)). Additionally, novel nanoparticles loaded with bacterial menaquinone have demonstrated potential anticancer effects through modulation of gene expression ([Scientific Reports](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Scientists have successfully captured flu viruses entering human cells in real time, providing valuable insights into viral infection mechanisms ([ScienceDaily](#)). A routine shingles vaccination has been found to offer robust defense against dementia, suggesting broader benefits of immunization ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Concerns are rising over bird flu's surprising heat tolerance, which may increase the risk of transmission and complicate containment efforts ([ScienceDaily](#)). The European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) has defined new strategies to combat avian and swine flu in humans, aiming to improve pandemic preparedness ([ECDC](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

The Fuego volcano continues to emit volcanic ash reaching altitudes of up to 14,000 feet, prompting ongoing advisories for air traffic and local populations ([Volcano Discovery](#)). Earthquake activity has been reported globally, including a magnitude 4.1 quake north of Yakutat, Alaska, and more minor tremors in California, reflecting the persistent seismic activity worldwide ([USGS](#)).

In space exploration, NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory hosted an invention challenge that brought student engineers to collaborate on innovative projects, fostering the next generation of scientific talent ([NASA](#)). NASA also received its second Emmy Award for the 2024 total solar eclipse broadcast, highlighting the agency's excellence in science communication ([NASA](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

In Europe, controversy has arisen over the European Union's proposed ban on the term "veggie burger," drawing public criticism, including from musician Paul McCartney ([Politico](#)). The populist right across Europe has welcomed the foreign policy stance of Donald Trump's team, particularly their criticism of the EU ([Politico](#)).



Qatar and Egypt, acting as mediators in the Gaza conflict, have called for the following steps to maintain the current truce and promote peace talks ([France24](#)). Meanwhile, Russia has launched a massive drone attack on central Ukraine as peace negotiations have stalled, intensifying the conflict ([France24](#)).

In Africa, loyalist troops in Benin have foiled a coup attempt, maintaining the current government's control ([BBC News](#)). The United Nations watchdog reported that the radiation shield at the Chernobyl nuclear site lost its safety function following a recent drone strike, raising concerns about nuclear safety ([BBC News](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Archaeological discoveries in the City of David have shed new light on ancient Israelite history. An Assyrian inscription dating from the First Temple period was uncovered, providing valuable historical context ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)). Researchers also revealed the largest dam in ancient Israel, discovered within the City of David, which illustrates the advanced water management techniques of the time ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)).

Additionally, a rare gold coin bearing the image of Egyptian Queen Berenice II was found in Jerusalem's City of David, highlighting the region's historical connections with Egypt ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)). A rare coin from the Year Four Revolt was also discovered, symbolizing the redemption of Zion during a period of Jewish resistance ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)).
