### **Israel & Jerusalem**

The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) revealed that a Hezbollah operative apprehended last year played a crucial role in managing the group’s secret maritime operations, highlighting ongoing security challenges posed by Hezbollah’s covert activities ([Times of Israel](#)). Four more victims of the recent Bondi attack were laid to rest, including a courageous couple who tackled the terrorist, underscoring the human cost of ongoing violence in the region ([Times of Israel](#)).

France’s human rights envoy declared that the chant “From the river to the sea” is antisemitic, reflecting the heightened sensitivity and international attention to language used in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, the film “David” has offered a behind-the-scenes look at the biblical king’s story, revealing aspects it could not portray, enriching cultural engagement with Israel’s biblical heritage ([Israel365 News](#)).

Israel continues to assert its strength as it and its allies confront rising antisemitism, lawfare, and shifting regional power dynamics, emphasizing the nation’s resilience in a complex geopolitical environment ([Israel365 News](#)). The revival of Christmas celebrations in Israel is seen as significant beyond tourism, marking a cultural and religious rejuvenation in the Holy Land ([Israel365 News](#)).

In political developments, an appointee for the Mamdani administration resigned after just one day on the job, indicating possible instability or internal challenges within the administration ([JNS](#)). Additionally, investigations have uncovered an Iranian network behind terror activities in Australia, highlighting the global reach of regional conflicts ([JNS](#)).

The group Palestine Action has been characterized as seeking martyrdom through its actions, reflecting ongoing tensions and radicalization within the conflict ([JNS](#)). On the economic front, shipping companies are preparing plans for the return to the Suez Canal, a vital artery for global trade that affects Israel and the region’s economy ([Al-Monitor](#)).



Diplomatic efforts continue with Lebanon-Israel truce committee talks expanding as the deadline for Hezbollah's disarmament approaches, signaling cautious hope for regional stability ([Al-Monitor](#)). Meanwhile, a global hunger monitor reports that Gaza no longer faces famine, though UN-backed experts warn that 100,000 people remain in catastrophic conditions, and heavy rains are worsening the plight of displaced Gazans ([Al-Monitor](#))([BBC](#))([BBC](#)).

In U.S. policy, former President Trump expanded the travel ban to include Syria and Palestinian passport holders, reflecting ongoing security concerns ([BBC](#)). The IDF has issued an evacuation order for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, indicating heightened military readiness ([Jerusalem Post](#)). The Israeli Defense Ministry will conduct a military exercise on Highway 35, and a Ukrainian drone attack on Moscow has forced the closure of an airport, underscoring the broader regional and international security tensions ([Jerusalem Post](#))([Jerusalem Post](#)).

## **Wars & Security (Israel and Region)**

A recent U.S.-led meeting on the Gaza International Stabilization Force ended inconclusively, while the IDF reported 12 ceasefire violations by Gaza from December 4 to 18, highlighting the fragile nature of the ceasefire and ongoing hostilities ([Long War Journal](#)). Israeli military operations against Hezbollah in Lebanon continued between December 8 and 14, reflecting persistent security challenges on Israel's northern border ([Long War Journal](#)).

Hamas has publicly acknowledged the killing of its senior commander, Raed Saad, a significant development in the ongoing conflict between Israel and Palestinian militant groups ([Long War Journal](#)). Meanwhile, European Union leaders gathered in Brussels to discuss the management of Russian assets amid ongoing geopolitical tensions ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

## **Apostasy & Religious Developments**



Reflecting on two decades of God’s faithfulness, Christian leaders and communities continue to emphasize the importance of steadfastness in faith amid cultural shifts ([The Gospel Coalition](#)). Young men are being called to seek more than pragmatic advice, with renewed focus on spiritual formation and biblical manhood ([The Gospel Coalition](#)).

The year’s best Christian music has been highlighted as a source of encouragement and worship, while the UniteUS movement is gaining momentum on college campuses, with thousands of students reportedly encountering Jesus through Elevation Rhythm’s ministry ([The Gospel Coalition](#))([Crosswalk](#)).

Kirk Cameron has announced plans for a roundtable discussion on the doctrine of hell following recent criticism, demonstrating ongoing theological engagement within evangelical circles ([Crosswalk](#)). Meanwhile, Albert Mohler warns of a growing clash between Western civilization and the Islamic worldview, underscoring cultural and religious tensions ([Crosswalk](#)).

Persecution.org highlights stories of believers rising through faith amid trials, while Nicaragua has banned Bibles at border crossings, signaling increasingly restrictive measures on Christian expression ([Persecution.org](#)). ## **Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering**

Scientists have discovered a novel method to slow aging at the cellular level, offering potential breakthroughs in longevity research ([Science Daily](#)). In a remarkable development, certain neurons, previously thought incapable of regrowth, have been shown to regenerate, restoring vision in experimental models ([Science Daily](#)).

Research has also revealed hidden dangers in the protective gear used by firefighters, prompting calls for improved safety standards ([Science Daily](#)). Studies on Moringa extracts demonstrate antifungal activity targeting *Candida auris*, a drug-resistant pathogen, opening new avenues for natural treatments ([Nature](#)).

Further research explores lipid metabolism in health and disease, while optimized extraction techniques for saponins from *Panax zingiberensis* show promise for medicinal applications ([Nature](#))([Nature](#)). In the biotech industry, BioMarin announced plans to acquire Amicus Therapeutics for \$4.8 billion, consolidating rare disease research efforts ([STAT News](#)).

## **Pestilence & Global Health**

A new approach to preventing gum disease has been developed that preserves beneficial bacteria, representing a shift from traditional treatments that indiscriminately kill oral microbes ([Science Daily](#)). Researchers have identified viral agents that may contribute to the persistence of long COVID symptoms, advancing understanding of this complex condition ([Science Daily](#)).

Studies show that children's anxiety and depression rates dropped rapidly following the reopening of schools after the COVID-19 pandemic, highlighting the importance of in-person education for mental health ([Science Daily](#)). The European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) released its communicable disease threats report for week 51 of 2025, providing updates on current public health risks ([ECDC](#)).

Lessons learned from the COVID-19 pandemic have prompted calls for enhanced crisis preparedness in Europe's public health laboratories, particularly for respiratory infectious diseases ([ECDC](#)).

## **Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens**

Volcanic activity remains notable with eruptions or alerts at several volcanoes, including Fuego, Popocatépetl, Soputan, Talang, Merapi, Bromo, Semeru, and Lokon-Empung, reminding us of the earth's dynamic and sometimes destructive forces ([Volcano Discovery](#)). Earthquake activity was reported globally on December 19, 2025, including minor tremors near Pāhala, Hawaii, and in Alaska, underscoring ongoing seismic activity ([Volcano Discovery](#))([USGS](#))([USGS](#))([USGS](#)).

The Reventador volcano issued a volcanic ash advisory with frequent emissions reaching 15,000 feet, posing potential hazards to aviation and nearby populations ([Volcano Discovery](#)).

In space news, the Hubble Space Telescope captured images of galactic gas escaping from a galaxy, providing insights into cosmic processes ([NASA](#)). Observations of Betelgeuse and the Crab Nebula highlight stellar death and rebirth, reminding us of the Creator's ongoing

Research conducted aboard the International Space Station has supported the development of a new FDA-approved cancer therapy, demonstrating the intersection of space exploration and medical advancement ([NASA](#)).

## **Global Macro & Geopolitics**

Russian President Vladimir Putin taunted NATO's Prime Minister Mark Rutte by asserting that the United States does not view Russia as an enemy, reflecting ongoing diplomatic tensions and strategic posturing ([Politico](#)). Ukraine struck a Russian shadow fleet tanker in the Mediterranean for the first time, marking a significant escalation in the conflict between the two nations ([Politico](#)).

Putin criticized the European Union's attempt to seize Russian assets, calling it an attempted "robbery," underscoring the deepening rift between Russia and Western institutions ([Politico](#)). In Syria, a trial is underway addressing post-Assad era violence, while the U.S. Congress has ended sanctions imposed during Assad's regime, potentially opening the door to new investments ([France24](#))([France24](#)).

Iran has been described as experiencing a "blood rain" in the Persian Gulf, a metaphor highlighting ongoing regional tensions and conflict ([France24](#)). In Switzerland, citizens are revamping fallout shelters and turning to bunkers amid growing security concerns ([France24](#)).

Putin stated that it is up to Ukraine and its allies to end hostilities, placing responsibility on the opposing side for the continuation of the conflict ([France24](#)). The European Union agreed on a €90 billion loan package for Ukraine, though it notably excluded the use of seized Russian assets, reflecting divisions among member states ([France24](#))([BBC](#)).

South Africa remains defiant after the United States threatened consequences following a raid on a refugee center, highlighting ongoing tensions over migration and security ([BBC](#)). In Bangladesh, newspaper staff recalled "gasping for air" as their offices were set ablaze, indicating escalating violence against the press ([BBC](#)).

Analysis of the Trump 2.0 administration's National Security Strategy suggests potential shifts in the international order, while Cambodia and Thailand have expressed willingness to de-escalate border conflicts, with China's foreign minister playing a mediating role ([The Diplomat](#))([The Diplomat](#)).



The inclusion of the Rohingya people is identified as a true test of Myanmar's future democracy, emphasizing the importance of minority rights in political development ([The Diplomat](#)).

### **Middle Eastern Artifacts**
