### **Israel & Jerusalem**

Israeli police have opened an investigation after a woman deliberately blew out Hanukkah candles in a Tel Aviv mall, an act that has stirred public concern over respect for Jewish traditions and religious symbols ([Times of Israel](#)). At the Turning Point USA conference, tensions erupted openly within the MAGA movement over differing views on Israel, highlighting the complex political and ideological debates surrounding U.S.-Israel relations ([Times of Israel](#)).

The so-called ‘Reddit Detective Agency’ played a pivotal role in the investigation of the Brown killer, significantly advancing the case through crowdsourced efforts and digital sleuthing ([Times of Israel](#)). The United States has carried out large-scale retaliatory strikes against ISIS targets in Syria, responding to recent attacks and aiming to degrade the terrorist group’s operational capabilities ([Al-Monitor](#)). operatives linked to Tehran, raising concerns about espionage and psychological warfare targeting Israeli citizens ([JNS](#)). The Israel Defense Forces have issued an evacuation order for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, signaling heightened military readiness and escalating tensions ([Jerusalem Post](#)). Iran executed a man accused of spying for Israel, according to the judiciary's news outlet, underscoring the high tensions and severe consequences faced by alleged intelligence operatives in the region ([Al-Monitor](#)).

The sister of the last hostage held in Gaza made a heartfelt plea for their release at the United Nations, highlighting the ongoing humanitarian crisis and the desperate need for diplomatic intervention ([JNS](#)). Palestinians have told the BBC they were sexually abused in Israeli prisons, raising serious human rights concerns and calls for an investigation ([BBC](#)). UN-backed experts report that food supplies in Gaza are improving, though approximately 100,000 people remain in 'catastrophic conditions,' highlighting the ongoing humanitarian challenges ([BBC](#)). ## **Wars & Security (Israel and Region)**

The United States launched widespread airstrikes against Islamic State positions in Syria following a deadly attack in Palmyra, aiming to disrupt terrorist operations and prevent further violence ([Long War Journal](#)). U.S. military officials highlighted ongoing anti-Islamic State operations after several soldiers were killed in Syria, emphasizing the continued commitment to combating terrorism in the region ([Long War Journal](#)). ## **Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering**

Scientists have made a breakthrough in understanding the 'junk DNA' that comprises 98% of the human genome, discovering links to Alzheimer's disease that could lead to new treatments ([ScienceDaily](#)). In a medical milestone, doctors successfully transplanted two new organs into an 11-year-old patient, marking a historic achievement in regenerative medicine ([ScienceDaily](#)). Research indicates that helping others for just a few hours a week may slow brain aging, suggesting a powerful connection between altruism and cognitive health ([ScienceDaily](#)).

A new technique involving injectable biological hydrogels has been developed to create a rich vascular subcutaneous space for cell transplantation, advancing therapeutic possibilities ([Nature](#)). Comparative studies on four Lagerstroemia indica cultivars reveal



their tolerance and phytoremediation potential under cadmium stress, contributing to environmental biotechnology ([Nature](#)). Researchers have developed a holistic valorisation process that turns lemon peel into textile materials using fungal chitosan and micro- and nano-fibrillated cellulose, showcasing sustainable innovation ([Nature](#)). The FDA approved Cytokinetics' new heart drug, Myqorzo, marking the biotech company's first major regulatory success and offering hope for heart failure patients ([STAT News](#)). Drugmakers have promised to stockpile certain medications as part of new drug pricing deals, aiming to ensure supply stability amid evolving healthcare policies ([STAT News](#)).

Francis Collins, former director of the NIH, expressed in an interview that he views science as 'glimpsing God's mind,' reflecting a harmonious relationship between faith and scientific inquiry ([STAT News](#)).

### **Pestilence & Global Health**

Researchers have developed a new method to prevent gum disease that preserves beneficial bacteria, offering a promising alternative to traditional treatments that often disrupt oral microbiomes ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Scientists have identified viral suspects that may contribute to long COVID symptoms, advancing understanding of the condition and potential therapeutic targets ([ScienceDaily](#)). Studies show that children's anxiety and depression levels dropped rapidly following the reopening of schools after COVID-19 closures, highlighting the importance of in-person education for mental health ([ScienceDaily](#)).

The European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) released an overview of avian influenza cases from September to November 2025, providing critical data for ongoing surveillance and response efforts ([ECDC](#)). Volcanic activity continues worldwide with notable eruptions and alerts at Santiaguito, Pacaya, Fuego, Popocatépetl, Soputan, Talang, Merapi, and Semeru volcanoes, as reported on December 20, 2025 ([Volcano Discovery](#)). A volcanic ash advisory was issued for



Dukono Volcano, with ash observed at flight level 070 and moving northeast, posing potential hazards to aviation ([Volcano Discovery](#)).

The World Earthquake Report for December 20, 2025, details recent seismic events globally, including minor tremors in California near Lake Henshaw, Idyllwild, and Searles Valley ([Volcano Discovery](#)).

NASA released a feature on wind-sculpted landscapes on Mars, investigating the formation of the Martian megaripple known as 'Hazyview,' advancing planetary science ([NASA](#)). NASA also shared the crew assignments for the SpaceX Crew-12 mission to the International Space Station, marking important milestones in human space exploration ([NASA](#)). Johnson Space Center highlighted its 2025 milestones, showcasing achievements in space science and technology development ([NASA](#)).

## **Global Macro & Geopolitics**

The Trump administration continues to release files related to Jeffrey Epstein, fueling ongoing public and political scrutiny over the case and its connections ([Politico](#)).
