



## Global Watch Daily – December 23, 2025

A concise summary of significant developments in Israel and the world through a grounded Christian worldview.

### **Israel & Jerusalem**

Recent events in Israel and the surrounding region reveal ongoing tensions and political challenges. Libya's military chief and seven others died in a plane crash shortly after taking off from Turkey, underscoring instability in North Africa ([Times of Israel](#)). At the United Nations Security Council, the United States and Iran clashed over the conditions necessary to revive nuclear talks, reflecting the persistent difficulties in diplomatic efforts to curb Iran's nuclear ambitions ([Times of Israel](#)). In Australia, lawmakers have advanced bills aimed at curbing gun ownership and protests, a response to the recent Bondi attack, signaling global concerns about security and civil order ([Times of Israel](#)).

Within Israel, political intrigue continues as former Prime Minister Netanyahu's ex-aide accused him of orchestrating an intelligence leak to the German newspaper Bild and subsequently lying about it, highlighting internal political strife ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, Israel is preparing for a second phase of conflict in Gaza as Hamas resumes its regime of terror, emphasizing the ongoing security challenges faced by the nation ([JNS](#)). The Israeli Defense Forces have issued evacuation orders for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, indicating heightened military readiness ([Jerusalem Post](#)).

In Jerusalem, an Anglican lay minister has been nominated for the role of security coordinator, reflecting efforts to maintain peace and security in the city ([JNS](#)). Additionally, Israel has approved 19 new settlements in the occupied West Bank, a move that is likely to affect the geopolitical landscape and peace negotiations ([BBC](#)). The government has also extended an order allowing the closure of foreign broadcasters, a measure that raises questions about media freedom during times of conflict ([BBC](#)).

Humanitarian concerns persist as NGOs warn that new Israeli registration rules risk the collapse of aid operations in Gaza, potentially exacerbating the suffering of civilians caught in the conflict ([BBC](#)). A baby who was treated abroad has returned to a Gaza



hospital, symbolizing the ongoing medical challenges faced by the population ([BBC](#)).

## **Wars & Security (Israel and Region)**

The security situation across the Middle East remains volatile with multiple fronts of conflict and political uncertainty. Iraqi militias remain divided over disarming and accepting government control, complicating efforts to stabilize the country ([Long War Journal](#)). In Libya, the parliament speaker has declared the maritime deal with Turkey invalid but expressed openness to renegotiation, reflecting ongoing disputes over territorial and economic rights ([Long War Journal](#)).

Israeli military operations against Hezbollah in Lebanon have continued through mid-December, demonstrating Israel's proactive stance against threats on its northern border ([Long War Journal](#)). Technological dependencies also emerge as the Pentagon and major artificial intelligence companies reveal a critical reliance on Chinese battery technology, exposing strategic vulnerabilities ([FDD](#)).

## **Global Macro & Geopolitics**

Globally, political and social dynamics continue to evolve with significant developments. In the United States, a tragic explosion at a Pennsylvania nursing home has resulted in at least two deaths, highlighting ongoing concerns about safety and emergency preparedness ([BBC](#)). The Murdoch media dynasty faces internal rivalries and rumors as the new order takes shape, reflecting the complexities of global media influence ([BBC](#)).

In Brazil, the Supreme Court has allowed former President Bolsonaro to leave prison temporarily for surgery, a development with potential political ramifications ([BBC](#)).
