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Israel & Jerusalem

In a notable event celebrating female leadership, eighteen women were honored at the inaugural Women of Iron awards, which also paid tribute to the late photographer Laura Ben-David. This recognition highlights the vital role of community leaders in Israel's social fabric ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, Prime Minister Netanyahu suggested that the current moment might empower Iranians to take control of their own destiny amid ongoing protests, signaling a potential shift in regional dynamics ([Times of Israel](#)).

Strategic moves by Israel to counter influences from Turkey and Iran reflect the shifting power balances in the Middle East, as analyzed in recent discussions on regional security. These developments underscore Israel's proactive stance in navigating complex geopolitical challenges ([JNS](#)). Additionally, warnings from Mosab Hassan Yousef emphasize that Western appeasement may inadvertently fuel jihadist momentum following the October 7 events, calling for a reevaluation of international approaches ([JNS](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

In East Africa, Somali intelligence announced the death of Abdullahi Osman, a senior Shabaab leader responsible for the group's explosive engineering and media operations, though Shabaab has yet to confirm this development ([Long War Journal](#)). Meanwhile, the United States conducted a significant military operation in Venezuela, striking key installations in Caracas and capturing President Nicolas Maduro and his wife, a move that has major implications for regional stability ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

Further regional security actions include Jordan's airstrikes in southern Syria targeting drug smuggling networks near the Jordanian border, coordinated with regional partners to disrupt illicit activities in the area ([Long War Journal](#)). These events collectively illustrate ongoing efforts to combat terrorism and maintain security across the Middle East and adjacent regions.



Global Macro & Geopolitics

The capture of Venezuelan President Maduro by U.S. forces has raised questions about governance and the future political landscape in Venezuela, with Donald Trump indicating that the U.S. will oversee a safe transition period ([BBC News](#)). This unprecedented action has sparked debate over its implications for authoritarian regimes worldwide, potentially setting a new precedent in international relations ([BBC News](#)).

Meanwhile, Sudan's Darfur region has experienced intense conflict, with at least 114 casualties reported in a week of fighting between the army and Rapid Support Forces. Drone strikes and ground assaults have resulted in significant civilian losses, highlighting the ongoing humanitarian crisis ([France24](#)). In response, Switzerland held a solemn memorial march for victims of a deadly New Year's Eve fire in Crans-Montana, underscoring global concerns for safety and justice ([France24](#)).

In East Asia, China's strategic approach to Taiwan involves military drills that increasingly erase buffer zones, reflecting Beijing's long-term plan to assert control without direct conflict. This strategy is closely analyzed as the West anticipates potential escalations ([The Diplomat](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Recent scientific advances have shed light on the rare heart inflammation triggered by mRNA COVID-19 vaccines, revealing a two-step immune response that can be mitigated to reduce risks, particularly in young men ([ScienceDaily](#)). Additionally, new research into oral bacteria communication offers promising avenues for preventing gum disease by promoting a balanced microbiome rather than eradicating bacteria entirely ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Long COVID continues to challenge healthcare, with studies identifying latent viral infections such as Epstein-Barr as possible contributors to persistent symptoms like fatigue and brain fog ([ScienceDaily](#)). Encouragingly, NAD+ supplementation shows early promise in alleviating these symptoms for some patients, while mental health among children has improved significantly following school reopenings, highlighting the importance of structured environments ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).
