### **Israel & Jerusalem**

Despite a ban, toxic hair treatments containing glyoxylic acid continue to cause kidney failure in dozens across Israel, highlighting ongoing public health challenges ([Times of Israel](#)). In a political shift, Abbas announced that the Ra'am party will open its candidate list to Jewish members, aiming to separate from the Islamic Movement and gain legitimacy ahead of upcoming elections ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, major anti-Israel influencers have been exposed for aligning with extremist rhetoric, intensifying concerns over misinformation and radical narratives ([JNS](#)).

In Germany, an arson attack targeting Brandenburg's antisemitism commissioner, accompanied by Hamas iconography, underscores rising tensions and threats faced by officials combating hate ([JNS](#)). Additionally, the IDF has issued an evacuation order for Tehran ahead of potential strikes, signaling heightened regional security concerns ([Jerusalem Post](#)).

### **Wars & Security (Israel and Region)**

Somali intelligence reports the death of Abdullahi Osman, a senior Shabaab leader responsible for explosives and media operations, though the group has yet to confirm ([Long War Journal](#)). The US military launched airstrikes on Venezuela's capital, capturing President Maduro in a significant operation that marks a dual victory in the war on drugs and geopolitical competition ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

Jordan conducted airstrikes in southern Syria targeting drug smuggling networks near the Druze-controlled Suwayda Governorate, coordinating with regional partners ([Long War Journal](#)). Iran condemned the US strikes on Venezuela, reflecting broader regional tensions ([FDD](#)).

### **Global Macro & Geopolitics**



US President Trump reiterated his controversial proposal to annex Greenland, emphasizing its strategic importance to the US ([BBC News](#)). In France, a court convicted ten individuals for cyberbullying against Brigitte Macron, highlighting rising concerns over online harassment ([BBC News](#)).

Deposed Venezuelan President Nicolás Maduro made his first US court appearance on drug trafficking charges, with legal debates over his immunity as a former head of state ([France24](#)). French President Macron stated France disapproves of the US method used to overthrow Maduro, though he acknowledged Maduro's dictatorship and the positive impact of his removal ([France24](#)).

In East Asia, China's military drills around Taiwan are increasingly aggressive, eroding buffer zones and signaling strategic intent, while Beijing pursues a plan to win Taiwan without direct conflict ([The Diplomat](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

## **Pestilence & Global Health**

Stanford researchers uncovered mechanisms behind rare heart inflammation triggered by mRNA COVID vaccines, involving a two-step immune response that recruits aggressive immune cells to the heart ([ScienceDaily](#)). Meanwhile, new approaches to prevent gum disease focus on altering bacterial communication rather than eradicating bacteria, promoting healthier oral microbiomes ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Emerging evidence suggests that hidden viral infections such as Epstein-Barr may contribute to long COVID symptoms like fatigue and brain fog by reactivating alongside SARS-CoV-2 ([ScienceDaily](#)). Clinical trials of NAD+ supplements show promise in alleviating long COVID fatigue and cognitive issues for some patients ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Children's anxiety and depression rates dropped significantly after schools reopened during the pandemic, underscoring the importance of in-person education and support structures ([ScienceDaily](#)). Additionally, AI-driven research identified a monkeypox protein that elicits strong immune responses, paving the way for improved vaccines ([ScienceDaily](#)).
