Israel & Jerusalem

Mobileye's acquisition of the Israeli AI humanoid startup Mentee Robotics for \$900 million represents a major milestone in advancing human-like robots for deployment in warehouses by 2028 and homes by 2030. This move highlights Israel's growing prominence in robotics and artificial intelligence technologies ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, diplomatic efforts continue as Prime Minister Netanyahu and Indian Prime Minister Modi discuss strengthening bilateral ties and a peace plan for Gaza, underscoring Israel's strategic partnerships in the region ([JNS](#)).

Tensions remain high with Iran, as the Iranian army chief threatens responses to hostile rhetoric from former President Trump and Netanyahu, while the country's judiciary vows no leniency toward the growing protests ([Times of Israel](#)). Additionally, accusations of antisemitism have surfaced after UK police labeled visiting Israelis as a threat, leading to a ban on soccer fans in Birmingham ([JNS](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Israeli military operations against Hezbollah in Lebanon have persisted into early January, targeting assets and personnel both north and south of the Litani River to maintain pressure on the group ([Long War Journal](#)). Concurrently, Somali intelligence reports the death of a senior Shabaab leader responsible for explosives and media operations, indicating ongoing counterterrorism efforts in the region ([Long War Journal](#)).

On the geopolitical front, Turkey's extensive ties with Venezuela have bolstered Maduro's regime despite international sanctions, raising questions following Maduro's recent capture by US forces ([Long War Journal](#)). Meanwhile, brave protesters in Iran continue to challenge the regime amid a complex convergence of dissatisfaction, with calls for freedom gaining international attention ([FDD](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics



Nigeria's former justice minister, Abubakar Malami, has been granted bail in a \$6 million corruption case, highlighting ongoing efforts to combat corruption across Africa ([BBC News](#)). Meanwhile, Yemen's separatist leader Aidarous al-Zubaidi faces accusations of treason amid Saudi airstrikes, reflecting the complex and volatile dynamics in the Arabian Peninsula ([BBC News](#)).

In Japan, organized crime groups are exploiting online recruitment through "yami baito" schemes, ensnaring vulnerable youth into illegal activities such as scams and burglaries ([France24](#)). Additionally, protests in Iran reflect a multi-layered dissatisfaction with the regime, exacerbated by economic and sociopolitical grievances ([France24](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Scientists have identified "migrions," viral structures that enable collective delivery of infection, accelerating viral replication and increasing disease severity. This discovery challenges traditional models of infection ([ScienceDaily](#)). In related research, Tamiflu has been shown to reduce neuropsychiatric events in children with influenza, overturning previous safety concerns ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Further studies explain why mRNA COVID vaccines can rarely trigger heart inflammation, identifying a two-step immune reaction that causes temporary injury and offering pathways to reduce risks ([ScienceDaily](#)). Additionally, rates of anxiety and depression among children dropped significantly after schools reopened following COVID closures, emphasizing the importance of in-person education ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 2.4 earthquake near Whites City, New Mexico, and a 2.0 magnitude event north of Sutton-Alpine, Alaska, reflecting ongoing tectonic movements across North America ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)).
