



Global Watch Daily – January 9, 2026

Israel & Jerusalem

Hundreds gathered in Mogadishu to protest Israel’s recognition of Somaliland, marking the third such demonstration since Jerusalem became the first UN state to acknowledge the region’s independence. Meanwhile, Bulgarian diplomat Nickolay Mladenov, nominated by the United States to serve on the Gaza board, maintains trust among both Israelis and Palestinians due to his previous role as a UN peace envoy. Additionally, the unique journey of S. Fitzgerald Haney—from Catholicism to Judaism—illustrates the diverse cultural and religious dynamics shaping Israel today ([Times of Israel](#); [JNS](#)).

Tensions remain elevated as former President Trump issued stern warnings to Iran, declaring they “will have hell to pay,” signaling the possibility of military responses. The Israel Defense Forces have issued evacuation orders for Tehran in anticipation of potential strikes, while the Defense Ministry is planning exercises along Highway 35, highlighting ongoing security preparations in the region ([JNS](#); [Jerusalem Post](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The search continues for the body of Ran Gvili, the last Gaza hostage, amid reports of 14 ceasefire violations by Hamas between December 19 and January 8. Syrian government forces have besieged Kurdish neighborhoods in Aleppo following recent clashes, reflecting ongoing regional instability. Israeli military operations against Hezbollah in Lebanon have persisted into early January, targeting assets both north and south of the Litani River ([Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#)).

Iran has reinforced its border with Iraq amid concerns over Kurdish arms smuggling, raising fears of further escalation. Discussions regarding the future of peace in Gaza critically depend on the disarmament of Hamas, even as courageous Iranians continue to protest domestically. This complex security environment presents ongoing challenges for Israel and its neighbors ([FDD](#); [FDD](#)).



Global Macro & Geopolitics

Elon Musk's Grok AI image editing tool has been restricted to paid X users following concerns about deepfake content, with government authorities urging Ofcom to consider imposing a ban. In South America, Venezuela has begun releasing political prisoners, a move welcomed by the United States, which recently captured President Nicolás Maduro. Meanwhile, European farmers protested in Paris against the Mercosur trade deal as the European Union voted on the agreement, highlighting tensions in global trade policies ([BBC News](#); [France24](#)).

In Southeast Asia, Thailand prepares for its upcoming 'Khaki Election' amid ongoing border tensions with Cambodia, with Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul's party poised to benefit. Meanwhile, Malaysian prosecutors have dropped charges against Deputy Prime Minister Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, citing the interests of justice. These developments reflect shifting political landscapes and governance challenges in the region ([The Diplomat](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Scientists have identified "migrions," viral structures that facilitate collective infection by bundling viral material for direct cell-to-cell transmission, thereby accelerating disease severity. Concurrently, new research has alleviated concerns about Tamiflu's safety in children, demonstrating that it may actually reduce neuropsychiatric events associated with influenza. These findings advance our understanding of viral behavior and treatment efficacy ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Further studies reveal that mRNA COVID-19 vaccines can, in rare cases, trigger heart inflammation through a two-step immune response. New approaches to gum disease focus on modulating bacterial communication rather than eradication. Additionally, research on long COVID suggests that latent viral infections may contribute to persistent symptoms, while children's mental health showed notable improvement following school reopenings during the pandemic ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 1.9 earthquake near Pāhala, Hawaii, as well as smaller quakes in Alaska near Karluk and Salamatof, underscoring ongoing tectonic movements. Meanwhile, NASA reports a winter shroud of fog over the Ganges Delta, with



low clouds blanketing the region during a cold wave. The agency also postponed a planned spacewalk due to a crew medical concern, emphasizing the importance of astronaut health and mission safety ([USGS](#); [NASA](#)).

Highlighting milestones in space exploration, NASA shared images from the Artemis II Countdown Demonstration Test, showcasing the international crew preparing for upcoming missions.
