### **Israel & Jerusalem**

US Jewish leaders have expressed concern over new political conditions attached to synagogue security grants, fearing that refusal to cooperate with ICE or the inclusion of DEI programming could jeopardize vital funding for safety measures. Meanwhile, West Virginia has updated its Holocaust Education Commission to address contemporary manifestations of antisemitism, demonstrating continued vigilance against hate ([Times of Israel](#); [JNS](#)).

Tensions remain elevated as the IDF has issued evacuation orders for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, while the US and Iran continue talks amid fears of direct conflict, underscoring the fragile security situation in the region ([Jerusalem Post](#); [BBC News](#)).

On a different note, a new book examines Jewish law's relationship with animal family bonds, exploring commandments involving mother birds and baby goats, and offering ethical insights that resonate with contemporary values ([Times of Israel](#)).

### **Wars & Security (Israel and Region)**

Syrian government forces have deployed in northeastern Syria following an agreement with the Syrian Democratic Forces, aiming to restore central authority in Kurdish areas amid ongoing US operations targeting Islamic State. Concurrently, Iran has intensified hostilities with the US, hardening its negotiating position while indirect US-Iran talks continue in Oman amid fears of war ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

The US is also signaling strategic shifts with its first warship visit to a Chinese-built port in Cambodia, reflecting new geopolitical dynamics in Southeast Asia. Meanwhile, expert testimony in the UK Parliament highlights the challenges posed by Venezuela's regime and emphasizes the importance of collective diplomacy in upholding international norms ([FDD](#); [Chatham House](#)).



Chatham House's Director, Bronwen Maddox, warns of the end of the Western alliance amid superpower competition, describing a revolutionary shift in US policy under President Trump that rejects foundational principles and international law, with serious implications for global stability ([Chatham House](#)).

## **Global Macro & Geopolitics**

In global security, Estonia's Narva exemplifies the NATO-Russia diplomatic standoff, as Estonia strengthens its borders and enforces Estonian language policies in response to Russian provocations. Pakistan experienced a deadly mosque suicide attack that killed over 30 and injured many, suspected to be linked to Taliban factions, highlighting ongoing regional instability ([France24](#); [BBC News](#)).

The US government has lifted its embargo on arms sales to Cambodia, signaling warming relations, while environmental concerns grow as plastic pollution continues to threaten ecosystems worldwide. Additionally, a touching story emerged of a Ukrainian soldier previously presumed dead who contacted his family, underscoring the human cost of ongoing conflicts ([The Diplomat](#); [BBC News](#)).

## **Pestilence & Global Health**

Researchers have developed a new nasal vaccine that shows strong protection against H5N1 bird flu, potentially preventing infection at its earliest stage. At the same time, a bat-borne virus has been identified infecting humans in Bangladesh, raising concerns about undetected zoonotic threats alongside the Nipah virus ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

A global study reveals that long COVID brain fog is reported more severely in the US compared to other countries, influenced by cultural and healthcare access factors. Additionally, research explains why some individuals suffer severe colds while others do not, emphasizing the role of nasal cells in early antiviral defense ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Studies also warn that bottled water, trusted by many in Guatemala, may be contaminated, while advances in synthetic bacteriophage engineering offer promising new tools to combat antibiotic-resistant superbugs, showcasing progress in global health science ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

## **Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens**



Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 1.3 earthquake near Campo, California, and a magnitude 0.9 earthquake near Idyllwild, California, both monitored by the USGS. Additionally, a magnitude 1.9 earthquake occurred near Livengood, Alaska, reflecting ongoing tectonic activity ([USGS](#); [USGS](#); [USGS](#)).

NASA reports that a strong, moisture-laden storm blanketed North Carolina with snow in late January, while new Earth System Explorers missions aim to enhance environmental monitoring and disaster mitigation. Weather forecasts predict Arctic air for the Northeast and increased rainfall for the Pacific Northwest, indicating dynamic atmospheric conditions ([NASA](#); [NASA](#); [weather.gov](#)).

### **Middle Eastern Artifacts**

Excavations on Ha-Te'uda Ha-Aduma Street in Yafo have uncovered military artifacts, including cannonballs and small-caliber bullets, linked to historical sieges in the late 18th century, shedding light on the area's turbulent past. Additionally, glass artifacts dating from the late 19th to mid-20th centuries reveal aspects of local daily life, including medicine and cosmetic bottles, reflecting cultural continuity from the Mamluk through Ottoman periods ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#); [Israel Antiquities Authority](#)).

Extensive salvage excavations at Khirbat 'Amra in the Be'er Sheva Valley have revealed architectural remains spanning from the Hellenistic to Early Islamic periods, marking it as one of the largest multiperiod rural sites in the region and providing valuable insights into historical settlement patterns ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#)).
