



Global Watch Daily – February 14, 2026

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A concise summary of significant developments in Israel and the world through a grounded Christian worldview.

Israel & Jerusalem

The exiled son of Iran’s last shah has called on former President Trump to assist in dismantling the Islamic Republic, coinciding with Trump’s deployment of a second aircraft carrier to the Middle East and his endorsement of regime change as the “best thing” ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, satellite imagery reveals Iran is fortifying an underground complex near its nuclear site amid ongoing talks with U.S. officials, underscoring escalating tensions ([BBC News](#)). The IDF has issued an evacuation order for Tehran in anticipation of possible strikes, highlighting the seriousness of the situation ([Jerusalem Post](#)). Additionally, the BBYO convention in Philadelphia emphasized liberty as a central theme, resonating from America to Iran ([JNS](#)).

In Gaza, Doctors Without Borders has suspended activities at a hospital due to the confirmed presence of gunmen, marking the first time an international group has acknowledged such incidents, including suspected weapons transfers, since the ceasefire ([Times of Israel](#)). This development adds complexity to the fragile ceasefire and ongoing humanitarian efforts in the region.

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The U.S. Treasury Department has sanctioned Jood SARL, a Lebanese gold exchange serving as a front for Hezbollah’s shadow bank, aiming to disrupt the terror group’s financial reserves ([Long War Journal](#)). Concurrently, Israeli military operations in southern Lebanon continue but with reduced intensity compared to previous weeks, reflecting a strategic recalibration ([Long War Journal](#)).

On the international legal front, Chatham House experts have provided evidence to UK parliamentary committees on the legality of U.S. actions in Venezuela, discussing implications for international law and the rules-based order ([Chatham House](#); [Chatham House](#)). Meanwhile, approximately 5,000 Islamic State detainees have been transferred from Syria to Iraq for investigation and prosecution, underscoring ongoing



counterterrorism efforts in the region ([Long War Journal](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

At the Munich Security Conference, U.S. Senator Marco Rubio advocated for a stronger transatlantic alliance, signaling a more conciliatory U.S. stance toward Europe compared to previous critiques, while encouraging allies to consider policies reminiscent of the Trump era ([France24](#)). In France, Storm Nils has broken all records, leaving vast areas of the southwest submerged and prompting continuous flood alerts ([France24](#)).

India's maritime diplomacy has matured significantly, as demonstrated by the "naval trifecta" event in Visakhapatnam, showcasing both hard and soft power capabilities ([The Diplomat](#)). Meanwhile, Kazakhstan continues its pursuit of Russians who fled the country through deportations and extraditions, reaffirming its stance on politically sensitive individuals ([The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Recent scientific advances reveal how life experiences, alongside genetics, epigenetically shape the human immune system, explaining varied responses to viruses ([ScienceDaily](#)). New nasal vaccines demonstrate strong protection against H5N1 bird flu by targeting early infection sites in the nose and lungs, potentially preventing widespread transmission ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Additionally, scientists in Australia have identified a unique sugar on drug-resistant bacteria, enabling the immune system to target and eliminate these superbugs more effectively ([ScienceDaily](#)). Meanwhile, a hidden bat virus infecting humans in Bangladesh raises concerns about undetected zoonotic threats alongside the Nipah virus ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Seismic activity included a magnitude 3.1 earthquake near Petrolia, California, along with smaller tremors near Dixon Lane-Meadow Creek, CA, and Leilani Estates, Hawaii, indicating ongoing tectonic activity ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)). Concurrently, NASA successfully launched the SpaceX Crew-12 mission to the International Space Station, advancing scientific exploration ([NASA](#)).



Heavy rain continues across the southern U.S., with active weather in Alaska, while southwestern France grapples with flooding from Storm Nils, underscoring the global impact of extreme weather events ([weather.gov](https://www.weather.gov); [France24](https://www.france24.com)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Recent archaeological developments include findings from excavations on Yafo's Ha-Te'uda Ha-Aduma Street. Fourteen military items were uncovered, including two cannonballs and twelve small-caliber bullets, shedding light on the area's martial history. Additionally, about fifty glass items dating from the late nineteenth to mid-twentieth centuries CE were found, comprising both imported and local pieces. Furthermore, the final report on the large-scale salvage excavations at Khirbat 'Amra, a rural site in the Be'er Sheva' Valley spanning from the Hellenistic to Early Islamic periods, has been published, providing valuable insights into the region's historical continuum ([Israel Antiquities Authority](https://www.israelantiquitiesauthority.org); [Israel Antiquities Authority](https://www.israelantiquitiesauthority.org); [Israel Antiquities Authority](https://www.israelantiquitiesauthority.org)).
