Israel & Jerusalem

Prime Minister Netanyahu warmly welcomed Indian Prime Minister Modi on his second official visit to Israel, marking a strengthening of strategic ties through agreements aimed at boosting security and economic cooperation. This visit reflects a decade of expanding relations between the two nations ([JNS](#); [BBC News](#)).

The growing Indo-Israeli alliance is causing ripples in regional geopolitics, notably challenging Pakistan's diplomatic positioning amid heightened security concerns ([Al Jazeera](#); [BBC News](#)).

Domestically, the Knesset preliminarily approved a bill imposing prison sentences for desecrating holy sites, including the Western Wall, following Supreme Court rulings on mixed-gender prayer spaces. Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The US State Department ordered the withdrawal of non-emergency personnel and families from its embassy in Beirut amid escalating regional tensions involving Iran and Hezbollah threats, signaling increased instability in the Middle East ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

Former Iraqi Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki remains determined to reclaim office despite US opposition, intensifying political uncertainty in Iraq as Shiite factions deliberate leadership choices following the 2025 elections ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

Highlighting the future of warfare, Ukrainian Ambassador Valerii Zaluzhnyi emphasized the need for technological alliances over traditional treaties, predicting that autonomous robotic systems will dominate future conflicts. Global Macro & Geopolitics

President Trump's recent State of the Union address was marked by appeals to his base and taunts toward opponents, offering little indication of policy shifts amid a polarized US political landscape ([BBC News](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

Meanwhile, a Chinese dance troupe's tour in Australia sparked a bomb threat against Prime Minister Anthony Albanese, reflecting rising tensions and security concerns in the region ([BBC News](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

Pope Leo XIV announced a historic first papal visit to Algeria, alongside a packed tour of Africa that included Angola, Cameroon, and Equatorial Guinea. This signals the Vatican's outreach to the continent and its rich religious heritage ([France24](#); [France24](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Scientists have engineered bacteria capable of invading and consuming cancer tumors from within by exploiting tumor hypoxia to trigger a targeted biological attack, offering promising new avenues for cancer therapy ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

A universal nasal spray vaccine developed at Stanford Medicine supercharges lung immune defenses to protect against COVID-19, flu, pneumonia, and allergens, demonstrating broad-spectrum respiratory protection in animal models ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Researchers uncovered a 5,000-year-old bacterium from an ice cave resistant to many modern antibiotics, revealing over 100 resistance genes and highlighting the challenges of combating antibiotic-resistant infections ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 2.1 earthquake near Midland, Texas, and a 2.2 magnitude tremor near Maria Antonia, Puerto Rico, both recorded by the USGS, indicating ongoing tectonic movements in these regions ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)).

Satellite radar images reveal landslide and avalanche debris across Hubbard Glacier in the Yukon, Canada, following a powerful earthquake, illustrating the dynamic and hazardous nature of mountainous environments ([NASA](#); [weather.gov](#)).



Middle Eastern Artifacts

Recent developments include the 1956 trial excavation on the western slope of Tel El-Ruiyan (Tel Roeh) on the lands of Sede Eliyahu in the Beit She'an Valley, as well as excavations at Tel 'Erani conducted in 1951 and 1957 under the direction of Sh. Yeivin. Additionally, a 4th-century basilica with a large reception hall has been excavated in Ostia, and researchers have used AI to decipher the rules of an ancient Roman board game, reflecting ongoing archaeological and historical discoveries ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#); [Israel Antiquities Authority](#); [BiblePlaces](#)).
