Israel & Jerusalem

Recent exhibitions such as “Eldercide” bring attention to the often overlooked suffering of elderly Jews during the Holocaust, highlighting their vulnerability and the hardships faced by survivors ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, tensions remain high as a French far-left lawmaker was detained for alleged online support of terrorism, reflecting ongoing security challenges in the region ([JNS](#)). These events underscore the complex socio-political environment in Israel and its surroundings.

International legal scrutiny is intensifying amid allegations of violations in the Iran war, with the White House affirming its commitment to strengthening regional security by addressing emerging threats ([BBC News](#)). At the same time, Israeli society is deeply affected by the prolonged conflict, which continues to reshape its political, economic, and social landscape ([Al Jazeera](#)).

Historical analyses of airpower offer valuable insights into the strategic aims of the United States and Israel in the ongoing Iran conflict, emphasizing the critical role of aerial campaigns ([Times of Israel](#)). Concurrently, international judicial processes advance as ICC member states vote to continue disciplinary proceedings against the chief prosecutor, reflecting broader efforts toward accountability ([JNS](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Between March 28 and April 1, Iran and its allied militias decreased the total number of projectiles launched but increased their accuracy in attacks targeting critical infrastructure and residential areas throughout the region ([Long War Journal](#)). The kidnapping of American journalist Shelly Kittleson in Baghdad by an Iran-backed militia highlights the ongoing dangers faced by foreign nationals amid escalating tensions ([Long War Journal](#)).

US strategy in the Iran conflict focuses on regional stability, with experts emphasizing that what follows military engagements is more crucial than victory alone ([FDD](#); [FDD](#)). Syrian President al-Sharaa has publicly declared Syria’s intention to remain outside the conflict



and has advocated for negotiated solutions to reduce regional disruption ([Chatham House](#)).

Humanitarian efforts persist amid ongoing conflict, with Sudan's volunteer-led Emergency Response Rooms recently recognized for their impartial aid work during the country's crisis, underscoring the vital role of grassroots organizations in war-torn areas ([Chatham House](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

International law experts have expressed concern over violations in the Iran war, while the White House insists its actions aim to secure the region against both immediate and long-term threats ([BBC News](#)). Leadership changes are underway in the US military, with Christopher LaNeve appointed to lead the Army, succeeding Randy George under the guidance of Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth ([BBC News](#)).

Iran's Revolutionary Guards Corps has launched a campaign recruiting children as young as 12 for homeland defense, raising serious human rights concerns and accusations of war crimes by rights organizations ([France24](#)). Meanwhile, the Israeli army announced plans to strike two bridges in eastern Lebanon, escalating military tensions in the region ([France24](#)).

Human rights defenders in Cambodia continue to face severe repercussions a decade after the ADHOC 5 incident, illustrating the fragility of international protections for local activists ([The Diplomat](#)). Meanwhile, Vietnamese fishers in the contested South China Sea endure physical violence and hardship, often without international attention ([The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

A breakthrough urine test promises to revolutionize the treatment of urinary tract infections by providing same-day results that identify effective antibiotics, bypassing lengthy lab cultures and achieving over 96% accuracy in trials ([ScienceDaily](#)). This advancement could significantly reduce treatment delays and minimize antibiotic misuse.

Research into long COVID has revealed a unique molecular state in certain immune cells, particularly among patients who initially experienced mild or moderate infections, offering new insights into the persistent fatigue and symptoms affecting up to 10% of sufferers ([ScienceDaily](#)).



Environmental health concerns have emerged as antibiotics accumulate in a major Brazilian river, with banned drugs detected in fish consumed by humans. While some aquatic plants show promise in removing these contaminants, altered drug absorption in fish presents unexpected risks ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 1.7 earthquake near Mentone, Texas, and a magnitude 3.3 event north of Charlotte Amalie in the U.S. Virgin Islands, as recorded by the USGS ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)).

Arctic sea ice reached one of its lowest maximum extents on record in March 2026, influenced by open water patches in the Barents Sea, underscoring ongoing climate change impacts ([NASA](#)).

NASA's Artemis II mission has successfully departed Earth orbit for a flight around the Moon, marking the first crewed mission of this kind in over 50 years and demonstrating significant progress in space exploration ([NASA](#)).

Additional seismic events include a magnitude 2.6 earthquake west of Akhiok, Alaska, and a magnitude 1.4 quake near Cobb, California, both monitored by USGS, highlighting continuous tectonic activity across diverse regions ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Archaeological discoveries continue to illuminate ancient interactions, including evidence of an Indian visitor in Egypt's Valley of the Kings and new reassessments of Queen Hatshepsut's historical portrayal ([BiblePlaces](#)). Studies also suggest that the destruction of the Jewish temple on Elephantine Island resulted from specific historical events, enriching our understanding of the region's past.

Further findings include a shipwreck off Dor dating to circa 600 BC that carried smelted iron, indicating early trade practices, and the seizure of rare coins linked to ancient Palestinian history, highlighting the complexity of regional heritage ([BiblePlaces](#)).

Excavations in the Negev have uncovered a Byzantine church adorned with colorful mosaics, and a lead sling bullet inscribed with a Greek word that reflects local humor was discovered at Hippos, illustrating the area's cultural and military history ([BiblePlaces](#)).
