



Global Watch Daily – April 25, 2026

Israel & Jerusalem

Recent local elections in the West Bank and Gaza marked a significant moment, as Palestinians participated despite Hamas and other groups abstaining, reflecting the complex political dynamics in the region ([BBC News](#); [France24](#)).

A Yale University report on public trust in higher education notably omitted any mention of antisemitism, with a committee member describing earlier accusations as serious exaggerations. Meanwhile, discussions in the Canadian Senate on Jew-hatred called for enhanced security measures but failed to address Islamic extremism, highlighting ongoing challenges in confronting antisemitism worldwide ([JNS](#); [JNS](#)).

Israeli police are investigating an incident in which officers allegedly cut a Palestinian flag from a skullcap, underscoring tensions within Israeli society. At the same time, Iran has resumed commercial flights from Tehran airport for the first time in two months, signaling shifts in regional dynamics ([BBC News](#); [Al Jazeera](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Russia is expanding its unmanned systems capabilities by recruiting for a new brigade connected to its Shahed drone production, offering young recruits pay without the risks of combat. Meanwhile, the Houthis in Yemen continue to express steadfast support for Iran and are reportedly considering imposing a toll on Red Sea maritime traffic, reflecting ongoing regional proxy tensions ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

In the United Kingdom, Lord Robertson emphasized the country's diminished defense capabilities due to overreliance on the United States, urging a shift toward greater military autonomy and stronger European alliances. Additionally, experts from Chatham House provided evidence to the UK Parliament on the critical importance of securing mineral supply chains to guard against Chinese economic coercion ([Chatham House](#); [Chatham House](#)).



Global Macro & Geopolitics

Ukraine endured a major Russian attack resulting in seven fatalities, including four in a strike on a residential building in Dnipro, amid ongoing conflict. Concurrently, Mali experienced coordinated armed assaults described as the largest jihadist attacks in years, signaling escalating instability in the Sahel region ([BBC News](#); [BBC News](#)).

In sports, Carlos Alcaraz, the two-time defending Roland-Garros champion, withdrew from the tournament due to a wrist injury, ending speculation about his participation. On the geopolitical front, China's military-civil fusion strategy has been quietly downplayed publicly but continues to influence relations with the United States, while administrative changes suggest Beijing's ambitions for deeper integration with Afghanistan and Central Asia ([France24](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Archaeological discoveries of a mass grave in ancient Jordan reveal the devastating impact of the Plague of Justinian, illustrating how pandemics reshape societies beyond the mere spread of disease. Modern research has uncovered a hidden virus within gut bacteria linked to colorectal cancer, suggesting new pathways for early detection and a better understanding of disease risk ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Scientists have identified madecassic acid from a Korean herb as a potent agent against drug-resistant bacteria, offering hope for new antibiotics. Additionally, bacteria have been found to "explode" to spread antibiotic resistance via gene transfer agents, shedding light on complex microbial survival strategies ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Public restrooms pose hidden health risks not from toilet seats but from airborne droplets generated during flushing and poor hand hygiene. Breakthrough nanodisc technology now reveals weak spots in viruses such as HIV and Ebola, advancing efforts in vaccine development ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens
