Israel & Jerusalem

Tensions remain elevated as Israeli strikes in southern Lebanon have resulted in the deaths of thirteen individuals, including women and a child, amid ongoing conflict with Iran-backed Hezbollah, despite a declared ceasefire. In Jerusalem, Israeli police arrested a man following an unprovoked assault on a French nun, underscoring the rising harassment of Christians by extremist elements. Meanwhile, US President Trump voiced dissatisfaction with Iran's latest peace proposal and criticized the US Navy's blockade of the Strait of Hormuz as a "very profitable business," signaling persistent friction in the region ([BBC News](#); [JNS](#); [Al Jazeera](#)).

In Canada, hate crime charges have been filed against rioters who disrupted a pro-Israel event in Toronto, reflecting ongoing societal tensions since October 7, 2023. Additionally, NATO is assessing the US troop withdrawal from Germany, which involves redeploying approximately 5,000 troops amid strained relations with European allies. These developments highlight the complex geopolitical and social challenges connected to Israel and its allies ([JNS](#); [Al Jazeera](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The United States has intensified its efforts against Iranian-backed militias in Iraq by offering multimillion-dollar rewards for key leaders linked to attacks on US personnel. Simultaneously, jihadi groups in Mali are expanding their control, encircling the capital Bamako and threatening the fragile regime, signaling a growing regional security crisis. In Europe, a stabbing attack in London targeting Jewish men was claimed by the Iran-linked Ashab al Yamin group, highlighting ongoing threats to Jewish communities abroad ([Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#)).

Further complicating the security landscape, a Hamas-affiliated charity continues to raise funds on a US-based platform despite the founder's militant background. Analysis suggests that Hamas's October 7, 2023, pogrom yielded lasting strategic successes, as



evidenced by increased attacks and influence both regionally and abroad. These developments underscore the multifaceted nature of conflict and terrorism impacting Israel and its neighbors ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

Despite a fragile ceasefire holding for three weeks, tensions between the US and Iran remain high. President Trump has rejected Tehran's latest peace offer, while Iranian officials warn of likely renewed fighting. Concurrently, Ukrainian drone strikes targeting Russian oil facilities aim to disrupt Moscow's war funding, though the broader economic impact remains uncertain. These geopolitical dynamics unfold alongside North Korea advancing its medium-term plans and Japan reconsidering its military role in the Middle East to secure safe passage through strategic waterways ([France24](#); [France24](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

The recent death of former Formula 1 driver and Paralympic champion Alex Zanardi at age 59 marks a notable loss in the sports world, while ongoing conflicts and diplomatic standoffs continue to shape global power balances. Together, these events reflect a world grappling with war, diplomacy, and shifting alliances in a complex international environment ([BBC News](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Recent scientific discoveries have shed light on both historical and modern health challenges. Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens



Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 2.4 earthquake near Guánica, Puerto Rico, and a magnitude 2.1 event near Ridgeway, Alaska, both recorded by the USGS. These minor tremors, along with a smaller quake near Julian, California, underscore ongoing geological activity across diverse regions. Meanwhile, NASA announced the retirement of Janet Petro, director of the Kennedy Space Center, and celebrated the Artemis II crew's ceremonial ringing of the Nasdaq closing bell, marking milestones in space exploration. Additionally, drought-stricken areas in the southern United States are experiencing some relief due to recent rainfall ([USGS](#); [NASA](#); [weather.gov](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Archaeological excavations continue to enrich the understanding of ancient Middle Eastern history. Recent digs at Tel Qedesh have revealed Early Bronze Age mudbrick walls and clarified stratigraphy. Salvage excavations at Tel Zeror uncovered pottery sherds dating to the Middle and Late Bronze Ages, shedding light on regional cultural developments. New publications from the Israel Antiquities Authority detail Roman-period burial caves near Tel Qedesh and a farmhouse at Giv'at Ma'at, contributing valuable insights into historical settlement patterns.
