Israel & Jerusalem

The extradition of Mohammad Baqer Saad Dawood Al-Saadi to New York underscores ongoing threats against Jewish and American targets, as he orchestrated attacks on U.S. and Israeli interests ([JNS](#)). Meanwhile, Israeli airstrikes persist despite ceasefire efforts, with Hamas confirming the death of a senior commander in Gaza ([BBC News](#)).

Within Israel, political instability grows as disputes over military conscription for the ultra-Orthodox threaten to topple the governing coalition ([Al Jazeera](#)). At the same time, antisemitic threats against Jewish U.S. Congressman Jared Moskowitz highlight rising tensions abroad ([JNS](#)).

Lebanon reports casualties from Israeli strikes amid a U.S.-announced extended ceasefire, yet exchanges of fire between Israel and Hezbollah continue ([BBC News](#)). In response to ongoing threats, Israel is training new civilian security squads in 67 Gaza border communities to strengthen local defense capabilities ([Long War Journal](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Israeli airstrikes recently targeted Hamas commander Izz al-Din al-Haddad in Gaza City, aiming at one of the last senior leaders involved in the October 7 attacks ([Long War Journal](#)). Meanwhile, Iraq's new government was formed with only 14 of 23 ministers approved, reflecting ongoing political challenges amid regional tensions ([Long War Journal](#)).

The recent U.S.-China summit highlighted a stalemate in relations, with neither side showing significant shifts despite high-level talks between President Trump and Xi Jinping ([FDD](#)). In the Indo-Pacific, the AUKUS security pact faces criticism, including from former Australian Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull, who described it as a “huge wealth transfer” to the U.S. and UK, underscoring challenges in trilateral defense cooperation ([Chatham House](#)).



India continues strategic efforts to counter Chinese narratives, demonstrating resilience amid regional rivalries ([FDD](#)). Israel's expansion of civilian security training near Gaza reflects ongoing attempts to bolster defense amid persistent threats ([Long War Journal](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

A joint U.S.-Nigeria operation successfully eliminated senior ISIS leader Abu-Bilal al-Minuki, whom President Trump described as "the most active terrorist in the world" ([BBC News](#)). In London, massive security operations are underway amid counterprotests, reflecting heightened domestic tensions ([France24](#)).

The tragic collision between a freight train and a public bus in Bangkok resulted in at least eight deaths, with the crash igniting a fire that engulfed the bus ([BBC News](#)). On the cultural front, John Travolta received a surprise Palme d'Or at Cannes, in recognition of his contributions to film ([France24](#)).

The Indo-Pacific remains a strategic focus, with analyses examining AUKUS's impact on North Korea's evolving grand strategy ([The Diplomat](#)). Meanwhile, Kazakhstan's Victory Day celebrations reveal a shift away from Soviet heritage toward national pride ([The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Researchers at the University of Maryland have detailed how enteroviruses, including polio and common cold viruses, replicate within human cells by recruiting both viral and human proteins, revealing a molecular "on-off switch" that regulates viral replication ([ScienceDaily](#)).

In oral health, scientists have discovered a novel method to prevent gum disease by interrupting bacterial communication rather than killing bacteria, thereby promoting healthier oral microbiomes depending on oxygen levels above and below the gums ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Additionally, compounds extracted from a Brazilian tree show promise against COVID-19 by blocking viral entry, disrupting replication, and reducing inflammation, offering a multi-targeted natural antiviral approach ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens



Recent seismic activity in Alaska includes a magnitude 2.2 earthquake west of Anchor Point and a magnitude 1.0 quake east-southeast of McCarthy, recorded at depths of 97.4 km and 5 km, respectively ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)).

NASA's 34th SpaceX resupply mission launched successfully, delivering new scientific experiments to the International Space Station ([NASA](#)). Meanwhile, the Curiosity rover on Mars managed to dislodge a troublesome rock after extensive robotic arm maneuvers ([NASA](#)).

Fire weather concerns and severe thunderstorms are forecast across parts of the U.S. through the weekend, as monitored by the National Weather Service ([weather.gov](#)). The Hubble Space Telescope captured an image of a galaxy in transition, revealing complex dust structures and distant galaxies shining through ([NASA](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Recent publications by the Israel Antiquities Authority highlight findings from Abu Ghosh (A-9347), including detailed maps and plans of ancient structures such as buildings and winepresses, enriching understanding of the region's historical landscape ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#); [Israel Antiquities Authority](#)).

Additional studies focus on seal impressions discovered in Jerusalem, shedding light on administrative systems during biblical eras, while ongoing archaeological efforts conserve significant sites such as the Shamash Gate at Nineveh ([BiblePlaces](#); [BiblePlaces](#)).

The enigmatic Copper Scroll continues to intrigue scholars, with new theories proposing it as a list of donations to Bar Kochba, thereby enriching the narrative of Jewish history and resistance ([BiblePlaces](#)).
