



Global Watch Daily – August 3, 2026

Israel & Jerusalem

Israeli President Isaac Herzog expressed optimism about the Board of Peace's efforts, highlighting positive elements in its approach. The series "Judeacation," hosted by JNS Middle East correspondent Josh Hasten, explores life in Judea and Samaria, presenting the region as the historical and spiritual cradle of the Jewish people, countering common misconceptions about the area often referred to internationally as the "West Bank." The series underscores the intersection of history, faith, and modern Israeli life there. Yonatan Netanyahu was the sole Israeli soldier killed while leading a mission to free over 100 hostages during recent conflicts ([JNS](#); [JNS](#); [BBC News](#)).

Israeli National Security Minister Itamar Ben-Gvir sharply criticized the Israeli judicial system, accusing it of siding with terrorists. This statement reflects ongoing tensions within Israel regarding judicial decisions and security policies. Meanwhile, Israel conducted airstrikes targeting military operatives in Gaza City, Khan Younis, and Deir el-Balah, aiming to weaken Hamas capabilities. Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

US President Donald Trump unveiled a 15-point Board of Peace roadmap that outlines the transfer of governance and security responsibilities in Gaza. The plan conditions phased Israeli withdrawal on verified Hamas disarmament, though the sequencing of these steps remains a point of contention. In Afghanistan, three anti-Taliban resistance groups launched separate offensives across Badakhshan province over two weeks, briefly capturing a district center and attacking Taliban positions in multiple districts without evidence of direct coordination. Israel accused Hezbollah of deploying an explosive-laden drone against its positions on the Ali Al Taher Ridge on July 29, violating the ceasefire that has been in effect since June 19. Hezbollah has neither confirmed nor denied the attack ([Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#)).



Former Israeli Prime Minister Naftali Bennett pledged to designate Qatar as an “enemy state” if reelected, citing Qatar’s alleged financial support for Iran’s Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps. Meanwhile, President Trump expressed optimism about Gaza’s future following the establishment of the Board of Peace, which was created to oversee the coastal enclave’s postwar reconstruction. However, the Board’s proposal has encountered significant obstacles amid ongoing challenges in Gaza’s reconstruction efforts ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

Egypt, which had previously observed Iran’s regional campaign from a distance, now faces direct impact. On July 29, a drone strike targeted the Egyptian port city of Damietta, damaging a U.S. gas facility and highlighting Iran’s expanding pressure campaign. Meanwhile, tens of thousands of migrants crossed from Morocco into Ceuta, Spain’s North African enclave, on July 30, many swimming around a breakwater due to lax Moroccan border controls; dozens drowned in the process. Lebanese security forces raided a Beirut home amid a family dispute and discovered a large weapons cache. Interrogations revealed the cache belonged to a member of Hezbollah, underscoring ongoing security concerns in Lebanon ([FDD](#); [FDD](#); [Long War Journal](#)).

A 21-year-old German man, who had previously attempted to join the Islamic State, allegedly carried out a deadly vehicle-ramming attack at Berlin’s Pride festival, killing one person and injuring 29 others. Former Marine and New York Times journalist Thomas Gibbons-Neff recently returned to Afghanistan seeking accountability and closure by locating a Taliban commander he had confronted in 2010. Analysts Bill Roggio and Will Selber evaluated the merits of Gibbons-Neff’s recent visit and its implications ([Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

Two Republican senators demanded a written assurance that former President Trump would not revive a controversial policy proposal. Antoni Vives, a policy analyst and former Deputy Mayor of Barcelona, provided a nuanced geopolitical analysis of the Ceuta migration crisis, emphasizing that the situation cannot be understood solely as a humanitarian emergency or a spontaneous wave of migration but rather as deeper political dynamics. Following the first joint intervention in 15 years by US and Japanese officials, the yen experienced significant volatility, reflecting their commitment to defending the currency. Oil prices declined after President Trump canceled planned military strikes in the Middle East and announced that US-Iran negotiations are set to resume. Pestilence & Global Health

An experimental antiviral pill demonstrated effectiveness in preventing the spread of a measles-like virus among ferrets, blocking transmission both through the air and close contact. Administered shortly before or after exposure, the drug also reduced illness duration and contagiousness, suggesting potential for future human use. Scientists have restored the efficacy of vancomycin, a powerful antibiotic compromised by bacterial resistance, by combining it with a small molecule called pghi-4 that inhibits a bacterial enzyme associated with resistance. Researchers are also applying evolutionary theory to cancer treatment, proposing rapid, carefully timed switches between therapies to prevent tumor resistance and improve cure rates, according to mathematical models ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Researchers have mapped how influenza A virus hijacks human cells, revealing a surprising mechanism that dissolves small nuclear structures and releases proteins the virus may use for replication. This detailed molecular understanding could identify new drug targets and aid in studying dangerous flu strains. Additionally, a naturally occurring compound found in foods like wheat germ, mushrooms, and aged cheese may enhance vaccine response in older adults. In a small pilot trial, spermidine supplements were given to adults over 65 following their third COVID-19 vaccine dose, showing promising results in strengthening immune protection ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

The United States Geological Survey recorded a magnitude 1.6 earthquake near Cobb, California, and a magnitude 5.0 earthquake near Suez, Egypt. Additionally, a magnitude 6.8 earthquake occurred near Uto, Japan. In Argentina, a magnitude 4.6 earthquake struck at a depth of 182.5 kilometers, affecting approximately 8,000 people within a 100-kilometer radius ([USGS](#); [USGS](#); [USGS](#); [GDACS](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Archaeologists recently uncovered a Ramesside-era tomb belonging to “Paser” on Luxor’s west bank. An Egyptian archaeological mission also discovered three New Kingdom rock-cut tombs at the Bubasteion Necropolis in Saqqara. These findings contribute to the growing body of knowledge about ancient Egyptian burial practices and religious sites ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#); [BiblePlaces](#)).
