Israel & Jerusalem

The series “Judeacation,” hosted by JNS Middle East correspondent Josh Hasten, takes viewers into the heart of Judea and Samaria, a region known internationally as the “West Bank” but regarded by Jews as their ancestral cradle. The program aims to dispel myths and misconceptions about life in the area, highlighting the intersection of history, faith, and modern Israel. Following the Alternative for Germany (AfD) party’s historic gains in recent elections, Israeli Ambassador Ron Prosor emphasized the urgent need to confront left-wing antisemitism with the same vigor applied to right-wing extremism. Former IDF Chief of Staff Gadi Eisenkot announced a list of “symbolic” candidates for his Knesset slate, including individuals affected by the October 7, 2023 massacre. The list is intended to honor those impacted by the tragedy. Meanwhile, Nauru’s Foreign Minister Lionel Aingimea expressed his nation’s commitment to Israel, stating, “Our motto is God first, and Israel always has a special place in our hearts.” Nauru recently opened an embassy in Jerusalem, further solidifying diplomatic ties. Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) reported successful clearance of Hezbollah fighters from underground infrastructure on the Ali al Taher Ridge in southern Lebanon, establishing operational control both above and below ground. Hezbollah, however, denied losing control of this strategic position. This confrontation highlighted the limitations of the Lebanese government’s efforts to secure the area. In a separate operation on September 1, Israeli special forces captured a senior Hamas security official in the Katiba area of western Gaza City. This raid occurred amid ongoing tensions surrounding the US-backed Board of Peace’s stabilization plan and Hamas disarmament agreement, which had previously led Israel to scale back military strikes.



The United States is reportedly reducing funding for the Kurdistan Regional Government's Peshmerga forces in Iraq as it prepares to withdraw troops from the country. This development comes amid intensified drone and missile attacks by Iran targeting the Kurdistan region, raising concerns about the stability and security of the area. On August 28, former President Donald Trump announced a landmark oil agreement between the United States and Venezuela, granting American interests majority control over more than 65 billion barrels of proven reserves. The deal is part of a 25-year strategy to expand US energy influence. Meanwhile, amid ongoing Russian sabotage efforts across Europe, NATO announced that Germany successfully completed a test launch of an Israeli-made ballistic missile in the North Atlantic. This test follows collaborative naval developments between Berlin and Jerusalem aimed at countering Russian and Iranian threats. In Europe, particularly France, debates continue over the US's strategic approach to Iran, with some analysts suggesting that while America has not yet secured victory, Iran may be experiencing setbacks. Turkey faces a political crisis as President Erdoğan contends with mounting opposition pressures. Analysts at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies (FDD) explore the implications of this turmoil and potential future developments. Abu Hudhayfah al Ansari, the official Islamic State spokesman for the past three years, was reportedly killed during a joint Saudi-Yemeni special forces raid in Hadhramaut Governorate. The Islamic State has not yet confirmed his death. In Iraq, efforts to bring Iranian-backed militias under state control face new challenges as Kataib Sayyid al Shuhada has set conditions for disarmament. Pestilence & Global Health

The compound pterostilbene has been shown to reduce abnormal fat accumulation in cultured mouse muscle cells by enhancing fat breakdown and improving metabolic function. In a year-long clinical study involving patients with severe gum disease, omega-3 supplements and low-dose aspirin matched the effectiveness of antibiotics, with approximately 58% of participants achieving treatment goals. This finding suggests alternative therapeutic approaches that could reduce reliance on antibiotics. Additionally, older adults vaccinated with the Shingrix shingles vaccine were 24% less likely to be diagnosed with dementia over four years, based on a study of over 500,000 individuals. Australia's ongoing bird flu outbreak raises concerns as backyard bird feeders become potential hotspots for H5N1 transmission. The congregation of various bird species at feeders creates unnatural interactions that may facilitate virus spread. Experts recommend ceasing bird feeding as the safest measure, while smaller food quantities, avoiding hand-feeding, and rigorous cleaning can help mitigate risks. ([ScienceDaily](#))
