Israel & Jerusalem

Despite Ed Miliband's frequent assurances of affection for Israel and reminders of his Jewish heritage, his message to Jerusalem remains consistently hostile. He emphasized the importance of telling the true story and remembering the victims, affirming the justice of Israel's war and the joint American-Israeli efforts against the source of evil in Iran. Meanwhile, rebel fighters have reportedly captured Perim, a strategic island located on a vital international shipping route, raising concerns about regional security and maritime control. Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The Lebanese Armed Forces (LAF) reported achieving “operational control” in three pilot areas in southern Lebanon, marking a significant development in their ongoing security operations. Their first detailed official accounting of arms seizures in these zones revealed that approximately 86 percent of the 1,818 items confiscated consisted of light weapons and ammunition. In the United States, concerns about the munitions crisis have prompted discussions about the causes, consequences, and steps needed to rebuild the defense industrial base and production capacity to meet national security needs. Former U.S. Ambassador to Afghanistan Zalmay Khalilzad recently met with senior Taliban officials and attended the signing of a major oil and gas agreement with a Saudi company, despite the U.S. State Department's insistence that he acted solely in a personal capacity. The LAF is intensifying its deployment in Nabatieh, southern Lebanon, while reinforcing positions in nearby Zawtar al Gharbiyeh, one of the pilot zones established under the June 26 Trilateral Framework involving the United States, Israel, and Lebanon. These deployments aim to strengthen security and stability in the region, though the mission notably excludes Hezbollah disarmament. ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#); [FDD](#))

Authorities in Kuwait, Israel, Turkey, and France have recently disrupted suspected Islamic State plots and arrested sympathizers, demonstrating the jihadist group's persistent ability to recruit and radicalize individuals despite over a decade of sustained counterterrorism efforts. Iran continues its campaign against Kurdish opposition groups in the Kurdistan Region of northern Iraq, carrying out a drone strike on September 2 amid the ongoing U.S. military withdrawal. This attack underscores the escalating security challenges facing the Kurdistan Region. Meanwhile, the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) report having cleared Hezbollah fighters from underground infrastructure at Ali al Taher Ridge in southern Lebanon, achieving operational control both above and below ground. The September 11 attacks continue to influence global counterterrorism strategies, with India adapting its approach accordingly. In Brazil, the annual inflation rate fell more than expected in August, offering relief to consumers as President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva implements social aid programs ahead of upcoming elections. Pestilence & Global Health

Recent research indicates that GLP-1 drugs, commonly used for diabetes and obesity, are associated with approximately 20% fewer chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) flare-ups, suggesting potential respiratory benefits. Additional studies have identified previously hidden bacterial groups linked to aging and colorectal cancer. The compound pterostilbene has been shown to reduce abnormal fat accumulation in cultured mouse muscle cells by enhancing fat breakdown and promoting metabolic health. A year-long study found that omega-3 supplements combined with low-dose aspirin matched the effectiveness of antibiotics in treating severe gum disease, with both approaches helping about 58% of patients reach treatment goals. The United States Geological Survey (USGS) recorded a magnitude 3.4 earthquake near Vieques, Puerto Rico, and a magnitude 5.9 earthquake near Lospalos, Timor-Leste, reflecting ongoing seismic activity in these regions. ([USGS](#); [USGS](#))

Additional seismic events include a magnitude 3.8 earthquake near Castle Rock, Washington, and a magnitude 5.9 earthquake at a depth of 111.763 km in Indonesia, which affected approximately 10,000 people with intensity level IV on the Modified Mercalli Intensity scale. ([USGS](#); [GDACS](#))
