



Global Watch Daily – September 14, 2026

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A concise summary of significant developments in Israel and the world through a grounded Christian worldview.

Israel & Jerusalem

Brigadier General (res.) Daniel Gold highlights the intensifying competition among nations for scarce resources, with countries increasingly prioritizing their own national interests. In this context, Hamas has perpetrated mass atrocities and subsequently sought to redirect global condemnation toward Israel. Meanwhile, the Iran-backed Houthi rebels have reportedly seized control of Perim Island, a strategic location along a major shipping route, marking a significant escalation in regional tensions ([JNS](#); [JNS](#); [BBC News](#)).

The rebel capture of a stretch of Yemen’s strategic coastline represents their most significant military achievement in several years, consolidating their control over key maritime access points ([BBC News](#); [Al Jazeera](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Saudi Arabia announced the closure of its East-West Crude Oil Pipeline after drone attacks originating from Iraq targeted the facility. This pipeline had served as a vital alternative route for oil exports to the Red Sea following the closure of the Strait of Hormuz. Israeli Army Radio reported that Israeli troops subsequently withdrew from a contested ridge, underscoring that progress on the ground remains contingent upon Hamas’s disarmament and Israel’s political strategy ([Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#)).

The Lebanese Armed Forces (LAF) reported achieving “operational control” in three pilot zones in southern Lebanon, based on detailed accounts of arms seizures. Approximately 86 percent of the 1,818 confiscated items are light weapons and ammunition. Concurrently, Saudi Arabia confirmed the pipeline closure on September 11 following multiple drone attacks the previous day, highlighting the ongoing security challenges in the region ([Long War Journal](#); [FDD](#)).

Questions persist regarding the nature and consequences of America’s munitions crisis, including how the United States arrived at this critical juncture. Addressing these challenges requires rebuilding the defense industrial base and expanding munitions



production capacity to meet strategic needs, as guest host Bradley discussed on Generation Jihad ([Long War Journal](#)).

Former U.S. Ambassador to Afghanistan Zalmay Khalilzad met with senior Taliban officials and attended the signing of a major oil and gas agreement with a Saudi company, despite the U.S. State Department's assertion that he acted solely in a personal capacity. Meanwhile, the Lebanese Armed Forces are intensifying deployments in Nabatieh and reinforcing Zawtar al Gharbiyeh, two pilot zones under the June 26 Trilateral Framework involving the United States, Israel, and Lebanon. These developments reflect ongoing efforts to stabilize southern Lebanon without directly pursuing Hezbollah's disarmament ([Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

Former UK Prime Minister expressed bewilderment over Russian forces bombing a stationary Ukrainian locomotive near the Polish border, an attack that occurred shortly after prominent Western officials had passed through the area. The European Union's top diplomat characterized the strikes as an attempt to intimidate Kyiv's international supporters. France 24's correspondent in Kyiv, Gulliver Cragg, provided detailed coverage of the incident. Over the past year, the country has also made significant diplomatic advances with Singapore and Indonesia, enhancing its regional partnerships ([BBC News](#); [France24](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

AI Dominion, Deception & the Antichrist System

The goal is to simplify agentic payment transactions for service providers, agent platforms and marketplaces while maintaining robust guardrails. Common trust signals can be recognized across the ecosystem, reducing integration complexity and duplicative agent identity verification efforts, leading to faster time-to-market and lower integration costs without sacrificing trust. Tan wants smaller, American open-weight artificial intelligence labs to use the same training techniques as American frontier artificial intelligence labs, giving the U.S. a more robust set of open-weight options that aren't Chinese. U.S.-based KPMG LLP has taken a minority stake in deepfake detection developer Reality Defender and plans to integrate its fraud-protecting technology into its business services. The companies did not disclose the dollar amount invested or how much equity is changing hands. The number of independent testing laboratories qualified to help biometrics vendors and enterprises with standards-based assessments is also increasing. A weeklong summer workshop brought higher education faculty to campus to explore how artificial intelligence and machine learning materials can be adapted for their classrooms (biometricupdate.com; [MIT News](https://www.mit.edu/news)).

Unico has announced it signed a definitive agreement to acquire Valida, “an Argentine biometric identity verification platform with an established presence in the country’s banking sector.” Unico is pursuing consolidation across Latin America, building on flagship operations in Brazil and Mexico as well as a strong client base in other countries throughout the region. The firm outlines its “hypergrowth strategy,” of which the Valida acquisition is an. For about two years now, leaders in the UK have been promising that, soon, people will be able to use a digital ID to prove their age when buying alcohol. In late 2024, Peter Kyle, the Technology Secretary at the time, proclaimed that, “by next Christmas, you won’t need to carry a wallet or risk losing important documents when heading out to celebrate.” Almost two years later, the UK changed the Mandatory Licensing Conditions for alcohol sales. The European Commission has sent a finalized U.S.-European Union border data-sharing framework to the Council of the European Union for approval to sign and provisionally apply, moving a potentially far-reaching system for reciprocal biometric and identity checks closer to operation as Washington’s year-end Visa Waiver Program deadline approaches. On September 10, the Commission proposed that the Council authorize the signing and provisional application (biometricupdate.com).

The primary inquiry has shifted from whether machines will integrate into human surroundings. They have already done so. Humanoid robots are moving rapidly from science fiction into factories, workplaces and potentially our homes, powered by advances in artificial intelligence and billions of investment. Pestilence & Global Health



Long-lived bats appear to combine potent immune defenses with unique mechanisms for eliminating damaged cells, which may contribute to their resistance to cancer and disease over decades. Researchers hope to uncover genetic insights from bats that could inform new strategies to protect human health as we age. Additionally, GLP-1 receptor agonist drugs have been associated with approximately 20% fewer chronic obstructive pulmonary disease flare-ups, suggesting respiratory benefits beyond their established effects on diabetes and obesity. Research has also identified previously unrecognized bacterial groups linked to aging and colorectal cancer ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Pterostilbene has been shown to reduce abnormal fat accumulation in cultured mouse muscle cells by enhancing fat breakdown and supporting metabolic health ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

The United States Geological Survey recorded a magnitude 2.4 earthquake near Valier, Illinois, and a magnitude 5.5 earthquake near Pelabuhanratu, Indonesia. These events reflect ongoing seismic activity in both North America and Southeast Asia ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)).

Further seismic activity includes a magnitude 6.5 earthquake near Teluknaga, Indonesia. Additionally, a magnitude 4.6 earthquake at a depth of 51.32 kilometers was recorded in Japan on September 14, 2026, affecting an area with a population of approximately 2.8 million within 100 kilometers ([USGS](#); [GDACS](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Archaeologists excavating the agora at Smyrna uncovered three rooms adorned with wall paintings and mosaics, offering fresh insights into the artistic and cultural life of the ancient city. Meanwhile, in northern Iraq, nearly 180 years of archaeological focus on Nimrud's palaces and temples continues to yield new findings, deepening understanding of the region's history. In western Türkiye, archaeologists excavating the ancient city of Adramytteion uncovered a mosaic from a 2nd–3rd-century AD villa depicting a cat and a dog, offering a rare, personal glimpse into Roman domestic life.
