Israel & Jerusalem

Recent political tensions in Israel have surfaced as the Knesset legal adviser accused MK Simcha Rothman of threatening him during a heated debate regarding the powers of the Attorney General, highlighting ongoing disputes within the government ([Times of Israel](#)). In the security arena, the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) are preparing for retaliatory actions following the targeted killing of a senior Hezbollah commander, marking a significant escalation in the conflict with the Lebanese-based group ([Times of Israel](#)). This strike represents the first Israeli attack on Beirut in several months, intensifying regional tensions ([BBC](#)).

Meanwhile, domestic incidents have drawn attention, including a police summons for a journalist accused of shoving an aide to Sara Netanyahu, reflecting the charged atmosphere in Israeli public life ([Times of Israel](#)). Acts of vandalism against Jewish sites have also been reported; a Yemenite synagogue in central Israel was ransacked and its Torah scrolls defiled, underscoring ongoing challenges to religious and cultural heritage ([JNS](#)). Additionally, an Iranian dissident delegation is currently visiting Israel, signaling continued political and diplomatic engagement amid regional complexities ([JNS](#)).

Efforts to negotiate a ceasefire in Gaza have seen slow progress as violence between Israeli forces and Hamas persists, with humanitarian conditions remaining dire; food kitchens in Gaza still lack essential supplies despite the ceasefire ([Al-Monitor](#)) ([BBC](#)). The United Nations Security Council continues to debate resolutions concerning Hamas disarmament, with concerns about the feasibility and enforcement of such measures ([Israel365 News](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Security incidents continue to challenge stability in the region. Israeli security forces in the West Bank killed a Palestinian police officer who had shot an Israeli soldier, illustrating ongoing violence in contested areas ([Long War Journal](#)). Clashes have also erupted



between Syrian government troops and the Kurdish-led Syrian Democratic Forces, indicating persistent conflict within Syria's borders ([Long War Journal](#)).

The Israel Defense Forces report that Palestinian terrorists have broken the ceasefire agreement eight times between November 13 and 21 by firing on Israeli soldiers, highlighting the fragile nature of the current truce ([Long War Journal](#)). In broader geopolitical developments, former U.S. President Donald Trump has urged Ukraine to sign a peace deal and has proposed a detailed 28-point peace plan aimed at ending the ongoing Russia-Ukraine war ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)) ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

Apostasy & Religious Developments

Faith communities worldwide continue to respond to challenges and opportunities. Maria Stephan highlights the power of faithful non-violent resistance as a means of social and political change ([Religion News Service](#)). The Episcopal Diocese of New Jersey has donated \$1 million to support medical treatment for Palestinian children, demonstrating Christian compassion in action ([Religion News Service](#)).

Orthodox Christian clergy visits with U.S. officials have drawn accusations of Russian influence, reflecting the complex interplay of religion and geopolitics ([Religion News Service](#)). In the United Kingdom, a massive monument dedicated to answered prayers has broken ground, symbolizing a public acknowledgment of faith's role in society ([Christianity Today](#)). Kenyan churches are actively addressing superstitions against disabilities, promoting dignity and inclusion within their communities ([Christianity Today](#)).

Reports from the persecuted church reveal grave concerns: more than 300 students and staff were abducted in Nigeria, prompting the International Christian Concern president to issue a call to action ([International Christian Concern](#)). Additionally, subcommittees of the House Foreign Affairs Committee condemned sham elections scheduled in Myanmar, highlighting ongoing political oppression ([International Christian Concern](#)). A priest in Pakistan has rescued Christian slaves, underscoring the continuing plight of believers under persecution ([International Christian Concern](#)).

Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering

Recent scientific studies have raised health concerns related to diet and medical treatments. A global surge in the consumption of ultra-processed foods has prompted



urgent health warnings due to their negative impact on public health ([ScienceDaily](#)). New research has rewritten decades of understanding about fat metabolism, offering fresh insights into obesity ([ScienceDaily](#)).

In the field of pain management, scientists have identified a tiny enzyme that may lead to safer pain relief options, potentially reducing reliance on opioids ([ScienceDaily](#)). However, a major pharmaceutical trial by Novo Nordisk found that semaglutide, a drug marketed for weight loss, failed to slow the progression of Alzheimer's disease, marking a setback in treatment development ([STAT News](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

New scientific discoveries continue to shed light on infectious diseases and their historical impact. Researchers studying a tiny ancient virus have uncovered secrets that could aid in the fight against antibiotic-resistant superbugs, offering hope for future treatments ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Studies of Long COVID patients have revealed strange microscopic structures in their blood, advancing understanding of this complex condition ([ScienceDaily](#)). Historical analysis has shown how a 14th-century story misled the world about the Black Death, emphasizing the importance of accurate information in public health crises ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Seismic activity has been reported globally, with several minor earthquakes recorded on November 24, 2025, including a magnitude 0.7 quake near Cobb, California, and a magnitude 1.4 event near Stanton, Texas, reflecting ongoing tectonic movements ([USGS](#)) ([USGS](#)).

Volcanic activity continues at Santiaguito, with volcanic ash reaching altitudes of 15,000 feet, posing potential hazards to aviation and nearby communities ([Volcano Discovery](#)). Other active volcanoes include Fuego, Semeru, Ibu, Reventador, Sangay, White Island, and Sakurajima, indicating persistent geological unrest worldwide ([Volcano Discovery](#)).

In space exploration, NASA commemorated 25 years of astronaut perspectives from low Earth orbit, highlighting the transformative "Overview Effect" experienced by those who have viewed Earth from space ([NASA](#)). The agency also awarded new contracts for liquid hydrogen supply, essential for future space missions ([NASA](#)). Additionally, NASA celebrated a decade of student involvement in growing food for space missions through



the “Growing Beyond Earth” program ([NASA](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

Political developments in Europe include the resignation of Spain’s attorney general following a Supreme Court conviction, signaling judicial accountability at high levels ([Politico](#)). In France, the Prime Minister attributed budget deadlock to partisanship and the influence of presidential hopefuls, reflecting political challenges ahead of elections ([Politico](#)).

In the Middle East, an airstrike in Beirut targeted a Hezbollah leader but also resulted in civilian casualties, further complicating the security situation in Lebanon ([France24](#)). The Israeli army chief announced the dismissal of several generals in response to the October 7 attack, indicating internal military accountability ([France24](#)).

Pope Francis has embarked on his first overseas trip to Lebanon and Turkey amid heightened tensions in the Middle East, emphasizing the Vatican’s diplomatic engagement in the region ([France24](#)). Meanwhile, Ukraine’s city of Kharkiv suffered deadly Russian drone attacks, underscoring the ongoing conflict in Eastern Europe ([France24](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Archaeological discoveries in Jerusalem continue to enrich understanding of the region’s ancient history. An Assyrian inscription dating from the First Temple period was uncovered, providing valuable historical insights ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)). Excavations also revealed the largest dam in ancient Israel, located within the City of David, demonstrating advanced water management techniques of the time ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)).

Additionally, a rare gold coin bearing the image of Egyptian Queen Berenice II was discovered in the City of David, highlighting the region’s connections with Hellenistic Egypt ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)). A rare coin from the Year Four Revolt was also found in Jerusalem, shedding light on Jewish resistance during the Roman period ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)).
