Israel & Jerusalem

Recent developments in Israel and Jerusalem highlight ongoing security concerns, archaeological discoveries, and significant religious advocacy efforts. A man was arrested for posting death threats against the Druze chief of the Coordination of Government Activities in the Territories (COGAT), underscoring tensions within Israeli society ([Times of Israel](#)). Archaeologists unearthed a dismantled Hasmonean-era wall in Jerusalem, dating back approximately 2,100 years, shedding light on a mysterious period of destruction and the extent of Maccabean power in the region ([Times of Israel](#) ; [Israel365News](#)). Additionally, a 2,000-year-old city wall was uncovered, further enriching the historical understanding of Jerusalem’s ancient fortifications ([JNS](#)).

On the diplomatic and security front, Iran announced that a dual national arrested during the June war is currently on trial for spying for Israel, reflecting ongoing espionage and intelligence conflicts in the region ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, Israeli authorities issued an evacuation order for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, indicating heightened military readiness and potential escalation ([Jerusalem Post](#)). In domestic politics, far-right Israeli politician Itamar Ben-Gvir wore a yellow noose pin to promote the death penalty for terrorists, a symbolic gesture stirring public debate ([JNS](#)).

Religious advocacy was marked by the arrival of evangelical leaders from 18 nations on a historic Eagles’ Wings advocacy mission to Israel, demonstrating international Christian support for the Jewish state ([Israel365News](#)). However, tensions in academic discourse were evident as a report controversially blamed Jewish students for hostility on campuses and labeled antisemitism as a “Zionist plot,” reflecting ongoing challenges in addressing antisemitism ([Israel365News](#)). Additionally, deep distrust between left and right political factions complicates the establishment of a state commission of inquiry into the events of October 7, illustrating the polarized political climate ([JNS](#)).

Finally, Bethlehem illuminated its Christmas tree for the first time since the Gaza war began, symbolizing a moment of hope and celebration amid ongoing conflict ([BBC](#)).



Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The security situation in Israel and the surrounding region remains tense with ongoing military and militia activity. In Gaza, an anti-Hamas Popular Forces militia leader was killed, underscoring the continuing internal conflicts and power struggles within the territory ([Long War Journal](#)). Tensions between Israel and Syria persist following an Israeli raid, with the White House urging dialogue to reduce hostilities, reflecting the fragile state of regional diplomacy ([Long War Journal](#)).

In Yemen, the Southern Transitional Council seized key areas of the Hadramawt Governorate from rival government forces, indicating ongoing fragmentation and conflict within the country ([Long War Journal](#)). The widening gulf between Iran and the Gulf states continues to shape the geopolitical landscape, with increasing tensions affecting alliances and security calculations ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

On the defensive technology front, Germany has fielded the first Israeli Arrow 3 missile defense system, a development aimed at countering threats from Russia and enhancing European security cooperation ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)). Public opinion in the United States shows that 60 percent of Americans approve of U.S. strikes against Iranian nuclear facilities, indicating support for proactive measures to prevent nuclear proliferation ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

Apostasy & Religious Developments

Religious and cultural developments reveal both challenges and opportunities within Christian and broader faith communities. In the United States, Somali immigrants are being recognized as a valuable gift to American society, countering negative stereotypes and encouraging cultural appreciation ([Religion News Service](#)). Catholic campus ministers are working toward culturally responsive ministry to serve Latino students better, fostering a sense of belonging and spiritual growth among this demographic ([Religion News Service](#)). A small London church has launched a new cultural mission inviting passersby to engage with its community, reflecting innovative approaches to outreach ([Religion News Service](#)).

Christian writers emphasize spiritual disciplines to combat temptation, with articles encouraging believers to remember Christ's victory in the fight against sexual temptation ([The Gospel Coalition](#)). The rise of online sermons brings hidden dangers, as some caution against the potential for spiritual distraction and misinformation in digital ministry ([The Gospel Coalition](#)). Meanwhile, Christian author Josiah Queen reminds Generation Z that



real life is found in Scripture rather than in digital devices, urging a return to biblical foundations ([Crosswalk](#)). Reflecting a positive trend, YouVersion revealed that Bible reading has hit record levels in 2025, with the most popular verse encouraging spiritual engagement ([Crosswalk](#)).

Persecution of Christians continues in parts of the world. Churches in Sudan have been vandalized amid ongoing instability, highlighting the risks believers face in hostile environments ([Open Doors](#)). Communist nations maintain persecution through intense scrutiny and bureaucratic red tape, restricting Christian witness and activity ([Open Doors](#)). In eastern Democratic Republic of Congo, Rwanda and the DRC have reaffirmed intentions for peace despite ongoing violence, signaling cautious hope for stability in a troubled region ([Open Doors](#)).

Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering

Advances in biotechnology and genetic engineering continue to emerge with potential health impacts. A new study identified a silent genetic heart risk that affects millions, offering prospects for early detection and prevention of cardiac events ([ScienceDaily](#)). Researchers discovered that a simple ingredient can significantly enhance the health benefits of kale, potentially improving dietary nutrition ([ScienceDaily](#)).

In a breakthrough for genetic medicine, scientists used CRISPR-free RNA base editing to restore hearing in mice with a specific nonsense mutation, demonstrating progress in treating hereditary hearing loss ([Nature Communications](#)). Additionally, novel nanoparticles loaded with bacterial menaquinone show potential anti-cancer effects through gene expression modulation, opening new avenues for cancer therapy ([Scientific Reports](#)). Functional dairy foods incorporating date pollen extract have been shown to modulate hypothyroid symptoms in animal models, suggesting alternative nutritional therapies ([Scientific Reports](#)).

Pharmaceutical developments include Kymera's drug showing promise in early-stage trials for atopic dermatitis, potentially rivaling existing treatments such as Dupixent ([STAT News](#)). Dyne Therapeutics plans to file for FDA approval for a next-generation Duchenne muscular dystrophy drug, advancing treatment options for this genetic disorder ([STAT News](#)). However, funding cuts at the National Institutes of Health have excluded hundreds of young scientists from starting their own labs, raising concerns about the future of American scientific research ([STAT News](#)).



Pestilence & Global Health

Recent scientific studies have provided new insights into historical and contemporary infectious diseases. Researchers uncovered a volcanic trigger behind the Black Death, linking environmental factors to the spread of this devastating pandemic in the 14th century ([ScienceDaily](#)). In modern health developments, garlic mouthwash has demonstrated unexpectedly strong germ-fighting power, suggesting a natural adjunct to oral hygiene ([ScienceDaily](#)). Scientists have also captured flu viruses entering human cells in real time, advancing understanding of viral infection mechanisms ([ScienceDaily](#)).

The European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) released its communicable disease threats report for the week of November 29 to December 5, 2025, monitoring ongoing infectious disease risks across Europe ([ECDC](#)). The agency also defined strategies to combat avian and swine flu in humans, emphasizing preparedness and response to zoonotic influenza threats ([ECDC](#)). Furthermore, scenarios for pre-pandemic zoonotic influenza preparedness and response were outlined to enhance global readiness ([ECDC](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Natural events and scientific achievements mark this period with notable occurrences. Multiple earthquakes were recorded near San Ramon, California, with magnitudes ranging from 1.6 to 3.0, reflecting ongoing seismic activity in the region ([USGS](#) ; [USGS](#) ; [USGS](#)). Several volcanoes remain active, including Santiaguito, Fuego, Popocatépetl, Semeru, Shiveluch, Ibu, Dukono, and Reventador, with a volcanic ash advisory issued for Santiaguito reaching 14,000 feet in altitude ([Volcano Discovery](#) ; [Volcano Discovery](#)).

In space exploration, NASA's Artemis II Vehicle Manager Branelle Rodriguez prepared the Orion spacecraft for its upcoming mission, marking a significant step in human spaceflight ([NASA](#)). Additionally, NASA held an invention challenge bringing student engineers to the Jet Propulsion Laboratory, fostering innovation and education in aerospace engineering ([NASA](#)). NASA also won its second Emmy Award for the 2024 total solar eclipse broadcast, highlighting excellence in science communication ([NASA](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

Global political dynamics continue to evolve amid digital regulation, regional conflicts, and diplomatic engagements. Meta has committed to a hybrid advertising model to settle an



EU digital rules probe, reflecting ongoing tensions between technology companies and regulatory authorities in Europe ([Politico](#)). The European Union's Council President, Antonio Costa, warned the United States against interference in European affairs, emphasizing the importance of European sovereignty ([Politico](#)). Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy is scheduled to meet with European leaders, including Ursula von der Leyen, Antonio Costa, and Mark Rutte, in Brussels, underscoring ongoing international support amid the conflict with Russia ([Politico](#)).

In Syria, the city of Homs remains trapped in a cycle of sectarian violence, complicating efforts toward peace and reconstruction ([France24](#)). One year after Bashar Assad fled Syria, the country continues to struggle with healing and stability, as residents attempt to rebuild homes with limited resources ([France24](#) ; [France24](#)).

In Africa, a hunt is underway for coup plotters and hostages in Benin, while in Nigeria, one hundred abducted schoolchildren have been released, highlighting ongoing security challenges on the continent ([BBC](#) ; [BBC](#)). Clashes along the Thai-Cambodia border have caused thousands to flee, reflecting persistent regional tensions ([BBC](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Archaeological discoveries continue to illuminate the rich history of the Middle East. An Assyrian inscription from the First Temple period was discovered, providing valuable insights into ancient Near Eastern civilizations ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)). The largest dam in ancient Israel was uncovered in the City of David, revealing advanced water management techniques of the period ([City of David - News in Antiquities](#)).
