



Global Watch Daily – December 9, 2025

A concise summary of major developments in Israel and the world through a grounded Christian worldview.

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Israel & Jerusalem

In a significant move, the Israeli government has granted final authorization for the establishment of eight new settlements, including several that were formerly considered illegal outposts. This decision marks a notable development in the ongoing settlement activities in the region ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, tensions remain high as Iran has publicly objected to the branding of a World Cup soccer match between Egypt and Israel as the “Pride Match,” reflecting ongoing regional sensitivities and political disputes surrounding the event ([Times of Israel](#)).

In a troubling criminal case, a French nanny is currently on trial for allegedly poisoning a Jewish family, with the motive reportedly linked to the family’s wealth. This case has drawn attention to issues of safety and justice within the community ([Times of Israel](#)). The United Nations has been criticized for what some describe as a campaign against Israel’s strategic high ground, highlighting the complex international dynamics and disputes over security and sovereignty in the region ([Israel365 News](#)).

In New York, Israeli President Isaac Herzog praised the resilience of Israel’s medical system during an event at the Shamir Medical Center, emphasizing the country’s capacity to respond to health crises and emergencies ([Israel365 News](#)), ([JNS](#)).

Israel has announced plans to reopen the border crossing with Jordan to allow the passage of aid and goods. This development could ease humanitarian concerns and facilitate trade between the two countries ([Al-Monitor](#)). Reports from the United Nations indicate that a shockingly high number of children in Gaza remain acutely malnourished even after a recent truce, underscoring the ongoing humanitarian challenges in the area ([Al-Monitor](#)).

Israel is currently reviewing reports that its troops may have been involved in the killing of a three-year-old child in Gaza, reflecting the sensitivity and scrutiny surrounding military operations in the region ([BBC News](#)). Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has stated that the second phase of Israel’s Gaza peace plan is close to implementation, signaling ongoing



efforts to stabilize the region and pursue a resolution to the conflict ([BBC News](#)). The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) have issued evacuation orders for Tehran ahead of planned strikes, indicating heightened military readiness and strategic operations targeting Iran ([Jerusalem Post](#)). Additionally, the Israeli Defense Ministry is set to conduct a military exercise on Highway 35 to enhance operational preparedness in the region ([Jerusalem Post](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The Israel Defense Forces have revealed the existence of a Hamas financial network operating within Turkey, highlighting the transnational dimensions of the conflict and the challenges of counterterrorism efforts ([Long War Journal](#)). Israeli military operations against Hezbollah in Lebanon have intensified during the first week of December 2025, with targeted strikes and security measures aimed at curbing the militant group's activities along the northern border ([Long War Journal](#)), ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

In Iraq, an investigation has concluded that recent drone strikes targeted the Khor Mor gas field, prompting the Kurdistan Region to request enhanced air defense systems to protect critical infrastructure from future attacks ([Long War Journal](#)). Meanwhile, analysis on U.S. sanctions policy emphasizes the importance of maintaining pressure on Russia to outpace its evasion tactics, underscoring the ongoing geopolitical contest between Western powers and Moscow ([Foundation for Defense of Democracies](#)).

Apostasy & Religious Developments

Efforts to integrate mental health care into American mosques are gaining momentum, reflecting a growing awareness of the need for holistic support within Muslim communities in the United States ([Religion News Service](#)). In cultural discussions, author Anna Rollins explores the connections between the decline of purity culture and the rise of diet culture in her book "Famished," addressing complex social and spiritual issues related to identity and self-discipline ([Religion News Service](#)).

Concerns about anti-Christian bias in academia have been raised following a case at the University of Oklahoma, where a student alleges unjust punishment due to their Christian beliefs, highlighting ongoing challenges for religious freedom in educational settings ([Religion News Service](#)).



In Syria, one year after the fall of President Assad, persecuted minorities continue to face uncertainty and hardship, with reports documenting ongoing struggles for safety and religious freedom in the war-torn country ([International Christian Concern](#)).

Tragically, a pastor was shot dead in Gujranwala, Pakistan, underscoring the persistent persecution faced by Christian leaders and communities in parts of the Muslim world ([International Christian Concern](#)). In Sudan, several churches have been vandalized amid ongoing religious tensions, reflecting the fragile situation for Christians in the region ([International Christian Concern](#)).

Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering

Recent research reveals that most of the global population is not receiving adequate amounts of omega-3 fatty acids, which are essential for health, prompting calls for improved nutritional strategies worldwide ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Scientists have identified a single enzyme mutation that acts as a hidden trigger in certain forms of dementia, offering new insights into the disease's mechanisms and potential therapeutic targets ([ScienceDaily](#)).

A case study reports that a patient's food cravings disappeared while taking the drug Mounjaro, but later returned with increased intensity, illustrating the complex effects of emerging medications on appetite and metabolism ([ScienceDaily](#)).

In dental medicine, a randomized clinical trial has demonstrated the effectiveness of laser-assisted socket seal surgery with bioactive glass for dental implant site development, advancing surgical techniques ([Nature](#)).

Research in Ghana highlights barriers to the uptake of assistive technology among persons with disabilities in urban districts, pointing to social and infrastructural challenges that need to be addressed ([Nature](#)). Additionally, preliminary evaluations of the antibacterial and phytochemical properties of Ipomoea purpurea floral and seed extracts suggest the potential to reimagine invasive weeds as sources of medicinal compounds ([Nature](#)).

Gene therapy has shown promising results in improving symptoms of a rare neuromuscular disease, marking a significant step forward in the treatment of genetic disorders ([STAT News](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health



Scientists have uncovered evidence that volcanic activity may have triggered the Black Death pandemic, providing new insights into historical disease outbreaks and their environmental causes ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Garlic-based mouthwash has demonstrated unexpectedly strong germ-fighting properties, suggesting a natural alternative for oral hygiene and infection control ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Researchers have captured real-time footage of influenza viruses entering human cells, advancing the scientific understanding of viral infection processes and aiding vaccine development ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Global Macro & Geopolitics



European Union leaders have responded to former U.S. President Donald Trump's criticisms by expressing pride in their leadership, despite ongoing political debates about governance and policy direction in Europe ([Politico](#)). In France, the far-right political faction has proposed reopening brothels, a controversial policy initiative that has sparked public discussion about morality and social norms ([Politico](#)). Former President Trump has sharply criticized European leaders, labeling them as weak in the face of immigration and geopolitical challenges, reflecting ongoing tensions in transatlantic relations ([Politico](#)).

Families in Syria continue to search for children taken during the Assad regime, as the country grapples with the legacy of conflict and human rights abuses ([France24](#)). Reporters Without Borders has named Israel as the country responsible for the highest number of journalist deaths worldwide for the third consecutive year, highlighting the dangers faced by media personnel in conflict zones ([France24](#)).

The International Criminal Court has sentenced a Sudanese militia leader known as the "axe murderer" to 20 years in prison for war crimes committed during the Darfur conflict, representing a measure of international justice ([France24](#)).

Russia has welcomed the recent U.S. security strategy that includes a pullback from Europe, viewing it as a weakening of NATO and a subjugation of Ukraine, underscoring the shifting dynamics of global power ([France24](#)). The European Union has launched an antitrust investigation into Google over its use of data to train artificial intelligence without compensating content creators, reflecting growing regulatory scrutiny of tech giants ([France24](#)), ([BBC News](#)).

Ukraine is preparing a new peace plan amid ongoing conflict, with President Volodymyr Zelensky ruling out any territorial concessions, signaling continued resistance to external pressures ([BBC News](#)).
