### **Israel & Jerusalem**

Recent events in Israel and Jerusalem highlight both ongoing conflict and cultural remembrance. A disturbing rise in violent attacks against Jewish individuals has been reported, with calls for strategies to counter this growing tide of murderous inhumanity ([Times of Israel](#)). Volcanic activity remains notable, with several volcanoes, including Santiaguito, Fuego, Popocatépetl, Semeru, Ibu, Dukono, Reventador, and Nevado del Ruiz, active as of December 15, 2025 ([Volcano Discovery](#)). The Ibu volcano has issued a volcanic ash advisory, with ash reaching altitudes of up to 6,000 feet, posing a potential hazard to aviation and nearby communities ([Volcano Discovery](#)).
