### **Israel & Jerusalem**

Heightened tensions between the United States and Iran point to a potential imminent conflict. Former IDF intelligence leaders and US officials warn that a war could last for weeks if nuclear negotiations fail ([Times of Israel](#); [FDD](#)).

Meanwhile, legal proceedings continue abroad as UK authorities prepare a retrial for activists involved in a 2024 raid on an Israeli defense firm, highlighting ongoing international disputes related to Israel's security ([JNS](#); [Times of Israel](#)).

## **Pestilence & Global Health**

Innovative scientific breakthroughs offer hope against antibiotic resistance, with new CRISPR-based tools and sugar-targeting antibodies showing promise in combating superbugs ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).
