Global Watch Daily – March 5, 2026

A concise summary of significant developments in Israel and the world through a grounded Christian worldview.

### **Israel & Jerusalem**

Despite ongoing conflict, life in Israel persists with remarkable resilience, as demonstrated by an Israeli couple who chose to hold their wedding ceremony in an underground shelter rather than postpone the event ([JNS](#); [toi.li](#)). Thousands face daily uncertainty regarding basic necessities, underscoring the human cost amid geopolitical tensions ([toi.li](#)). Meanwhile, Israel is actively working to reshape regional alliances to counter emerging threats, aiming to establish a new multilateral axis to address challenges, including Iran's expanding influence ([JNS](#)). These efforts unfold as Iran intensifies attacks on Kurdish forces in Iraq, further destabilizing the region ([BBC News](#)).

Legal repercussions of regional conflicts extend abroad, exemplified by the sentencing of a Syrian man for a stabbing at the Berlin Holocaust memorial, highlighting the global reach of these tensions ([Times of Israel](#)). The intricate interplay of military, social, and diplomatic dynamics within Israel and its neighbors continues to influence the broader Middle Eastern landscape ([JNS](#); [toi.li](#)).

### **Wars & Security (Israel and Region)**

Over the course of four days, Israel has launched more than 1,600 airstrikes targeting Iranian leadership and military infrastructure, while enduring missile and drone attacks that have resulted in civilian casualties and widespread disruption ([Long War Journal](#)). Reports indicate a decline in Iranian ballistic missile launches, attributed to effective US and Israeli counterstrikes, signaling a shift in the conflict's dynamics ([Long War Journal](#)).

Protests orchestrated by Iran's regional allies have erupted across the Middle East and South Asia, with some demonstrations turning violent and threatening US diplomatic missions ([Long War Journal](#)). Concurrently, Iraqi Shiite militias backed by Iran continue their attacks on US bases, further escalating tensions ([Long War Journal](#)). Russia's nuclear threats and propaganda campaigns add complexity to the security environment, raising concerns about an arms race without direct nuclear detonation ([FDD](#); [FDD](#)).



## **Global Macro & Geopolitics**

Nepal is conducting its first election since a Gen Z-led uprising, testing the country's readiness for a new generation of leadership ([BBC News](#)). Meanwhile, the ongoing conflict in the Middle East has disrupted maritime traffic through the Strait of Hormuz, a vital global shipping lane, as revealed by recent timelapse footage ([BBC News](#)).

Israel's continued airstrikes in Lebanon have displaced over 83,000 people, with Hezbollah's involvement broadening the conflict's scope ([France24](#)). At the same time, intensive airstrikes in Iran have escalated, targeting both military and civilian sites, prompting vows of retaliation that extend far beyond the immediate battle zone ([France24](#)). Regional diplomacy remains strained, with Saudi Arabia cautious about deeper involvement and Pakistan's diplomatic stance shifting amid the conflict ([The Diplomat](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

## **Pestilence & Global Health**

Scientists have identified Aurora-related kinase 1 (ARK1), a protein essential for malaria parasite replication, offering a promising new target for treatments aimed at halting the disease's spread ([ScienceDaily](#)). In parallel, researchers have engineered bacteria capable of invading and consuming cancer tumors from within, representing an innovative therapeutic approach ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Additional advances include a universal nasal spray vaccine that enhances lung immunity against COVID-19, influenza, pneumonia, and allergens, demonstrating broad protective potential ([ScienceDaily](#)). Moreover, a shingles vaccine has been linked to slower biological aging and reduced inflammation in older adults, suggesting benefits beyond infection prevention ([ScienceDaily](#)). Meanwhile, a 5,000-year-old bacterium discovered in an ice cave exhibits resistance to modern antibiotics, highlighting ongoing challenges in combating superbugs ([ScienceDaily](#)).

## **Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens**

Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 1.8 earthquake near Pāhala, Hawaii, and a 1.7-magnitude event near Aleneva, Alaska, both recorded by the USGS ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)). Additionally, a smaller 1.0 magnitude quake was detected near Mammoth Lakes, California ([USGS](#)).

The US weather service forecasts severe thunderstorms in the central United States and record high temperatures in the eastern regions ([weather.gov](#)).

### **Middle Eastern Artifacts**

The Israel Antiquities Authority continues to release findings from excavations at Jerusalem's Giv'at Shapira site, uncovering significant artifacts that enrich understanding of the region's history ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#); [Israel Antiquities Authority](#)). Additionally, rare artifacts such as a half-shekel coin from the First Jewish Revolt and Crusader swords have been uncovered, further enriching the archaeological narrative ([BiblePlaces](#)).
