Israel & Jerusalem

Arkia Airlines has reversed its earlier plan to operate long-haul flights from Jordan and Egypt, now confirming that departures will originate from Israel with a passenger limit of 50 per plane, resulting in widespread cancellations ([Times of Israel](#)). Meanwhile, the IDF struck a key Iranian missile and naval mine production facility in Yazd, aiming to disrupt Tehran's maritime weapons capabilities amid ongoing regional tensions ([JNS](#)). These military actions coincide with warnings from Israeli officials about intensifying strikes on Iran in response to persistent missile attacks targeting civilian areas, underscoring escalating conflict dynamics ([Times of Israel](#)). At the same time, political discourse within Israel highlights the importance of reciprocal civic duty, with leaders such as Harush Gity emphasizing Haredi military service as a top national priority ([JNS](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Turkey continues its strategic engagement with Hamas, demonstrated by a recent meeting between Turkish intelligence chief Ibrahim Kalin and senior Hamas leaders in Istanbul, highlighting Ankara's mediator role in Gaza ceasefire talks without addressing Hamas disarmament ([Long War Journal](#)). In Venezuela, political shifts include the removal of the defense chief by interim President Delcy Rodríguez amid US-backed stabilization efforts, although repression reportedly persists according to UN findings ([Long War Journal](#)). Meanwhile, former President Trump has extended pauses and deadlines concerning strikes on Iranian energy infrastructure and the Strait of Hormuz, reflecting ongoing diplomatic maneuvering in the region ([FDD](#)). Additionally, young innovators are contributing ideas for AI adoption in governance through a recent policy hackathon, highlighting the intersection of technology and security policy ([Chatham House](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

In global media, US television personality Savannah Guthrie is set to return to NBC's Today show amid ongoing personal challenges ([BBC News](#)). Spain faces scrutiny over euthanasia



practices following the death of Noelia Castillo, sparking debate about state responsibility ([BBC News](#)). The ultra-conservative Catholic group Opus Dei continues to exert influence across Spanish society despite controversies, reflecting enduring religious and political currents ([France24](#)). In sports, Donald Trump claims credit for the IOC's transgender athlete ban at the 2028 LA Olympics, a move that has drawn mixed international reactions ([Al Jazeera](#); [France24](#)).
