Israel & Jerusalem

Recent violence in Israel and Gaza has led to tragic casualties, including a seven-year-old Israeli girl who was critically wounded by an Iranian missile and has now been discharged from the hospital. Additionally, an Israeli strike near a mosque in Beit Lahia killed five Palestinians, among them three children ([JNS](#); [BBC News](#)).

Lebanon has accused Israel of targeting a journalist killed in an airstrike, with the Lebanese prime minister condemning these attacks as war crimes, especially after Red Cross vehicles were prevented from reaching the site ([BBC News](#); [JNS](#)).

Beyond the immediate conflict zone, political and social tensions persist. Indian Muslim voters in West Bengal face disenfranchisement amid state elections, while concerns over religious freedoms have been raised at Williams College in the United States, highlighting broader issues of rights and representation ([Al Jazeera](#); [JNS](#)).

The economic consequences of the ongoing US-Israel war on Iran are under analysis, revealing clear winners and losers within the regional and global economy ([Al Jazeera](#)).

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

Tensions in the Middle East remain high as Iran attacks vessels in the Strait of Hormuz while avoiding a definitive position on the US ceasefire extension, threatening regional oil and digital infrastructure. Hamas has expressed willingness to surrender some weapons, though it stops short of the full disarmament demanded by peace plans, while the IDF reports multiple recent ceasefire violations ([Long War Journal](#); [Long War Journal](#)).

US President Trump has extended the ceasefire with Iran, though peace talks remain stalled amid ongoing threats and geopolitical maneuvering. Meanwhile, US lawmakers and experts have raised alarms about the growing Iran-Russia axis, underscoring the complexity of regional security challenges ([FDD](#); [FDD](#)).



Iraq faces political uncertainty as Shiite parties delay nominating a new prime minister amid US warnings of Iran-backed threats, while the IRGC-QF commander visits Baghdad. At the same time, the United Kingdom is focusing on economic security by addressing China's dominance in critical minerals, emphasizing the need for resilience against supply chain weaponization ([Long War Journal](#); [Chatham House](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

Pope Leo concluded his tour of Africa with a candid critique of prison conditions in Equatorial Guinea, reflecting his ongoing commitment to social justice. In Southern Africa, a South African court has ordered Zambia to return the body of former president Edgar Lungu amid disputes between family and government over his burial location ([BBC News](#); [BBC News](#)).

Humanitarian efforts continue worldwide, with Ukraine's 'Food from Ukraine' program expanding its reach to Africa, improving aid distribution despite financial constraints. Concurrently, the Trump administration's blockade of nearly \$500 million in Iraqi oil revenues aims to pressure Baghdad to dismantle Iranian-backed armed groups, risking economic destabilization ([France24](#); [France24](#)).

In Asia, Vietnam and South Korea have agreed to strengthen cooperation on supply chains and nuclear energy, underscoring the growing importance of regional partnerships amid the conflicts in the Middle East. Meanwhile, Thailand faces escalating fuel smuggling problems exacerbated by the Hormuz oil crisis, challenging Prime Minister Anutin's government to address this pressing national security concern ([The Diplomat](#); [The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Groundbreaking research has identified a hidden virus within gut bacteria linked to colorectal cancer, opening new avenues for early detection and understanding disease risk. Additionally, scientists have discovered that a skincare compound derived from *Centella asiatica* can effectively kill drug-resistant bacteria by targeting unique bacterial proteins, heralding a promising new antibiotic approach ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Further studies reveal that bacteria can 'explode' to spread antibiotic resistance via gene-transfer agents, highlighting complex microbial communication mechanisms. Public health insights also emphasize that the greatest germ risks in restrooms come not from toilet



seats but from 'toilet plumes' and poor hand hygiene, shifting the focus toward improved sanitation practices ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Innovative nanodisc technology has revealed hidden vulnerabilities in viruses such as HIV and Ebola, enhancing understanding of immune responses and accelerating vaccine development. Moreover, scientists have finally elucidated the cause of rare blood clots following certain COVID-19 vaccines, enabling the design of safer vaccines without compromising efficacy ([ScienceDaily](#); [ScienceDaily](#)).

Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 3.3 earthquake near Grapevine, California, and a smaller 0.8 magnitude quake near Borrego Springs, California, both recorded by the USGS. Additionally, a 2.6-magnitude event occurred southeast of Silver Springs, Nevada, indicating ongoing tectonic activity in the western United States ([USGS](#); [USGS](#); [USGS](#)).

Seasonal fires have enveloped northern Thailand in smoke, affecting air quality and visibility across Southeast Asia. Meanwhile, severe weather threatens the central United States with critical fire weather conditions in the Southern Plains, as forecasted by the National Weather Service ([NASA](#); [weather.gov](#)).

NASA has announced the release of the 2026 SBIR/STTR Phase I and II solicitations, inviting proposals by May 21 and highlighting ongoing innovation in space technology and research ([NASA](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Recent archaeological discoveries include painted sarcophagi and papyrus scrolls from Egypt's Third Intermediate Period found near Luxor, shedding light on ancient funerary practices. Excavations have also uncovered a temple dedicated to the local god Pelusius, enriching understanding of regional religious history ([BiblePlaces](#)).

Studies of sheep and goat teeth reveal that shepherds migrated with their flocks between Galilee and the Golan Heights during the 10th to 8th centuries BC, despite ongoing conflicts. Additionally, a mass grave for children discovered at Azekah and the reopening of holy sites in Jerusalem offer new insights into biblical-era life and worship ([BiblePlaces](#)).
