Israel & Jerusalem

Israeli-American Tomer Malchi highlights how agricultural science transcends political divides, emphasizing irrigation and plant cultivation as universal languages that unite diverse groups ([JNS](#)). Meanwhile, Israeli supermarkets are preparing for significant increases in dairy prices, as three companies control 85% of the market and charge prices more than 50% above international levels ([JNS](#)). This economic strain adds to ongoing regional tensions, with Israeli strikes in southern Lebanon causing thirteen deaths, including women and children, despite a fragile ceasefire ([BBC News](#)).

Across the broader Middle East, ordinary Iranians voice concerns about increased repression following recent conflicts, fearing a more entrenched regime bent on revenge ([BBC News](#)). In India, Modi's BJP secured a historic victory in West Bengal by leveraging religious polarization and anti-incumbency sentiments ([Al Jazeera](#)), signaling a significant shift in regional political dynamics.

Wars & Security (Israel and Region)

The United States has intensified pressure on Iranian-backed militias in Iraq by offering multimillion-dollar rewards for leaders of Kataib Hezbollah, Kataib Sayyid al Shuhada, and Harakat Ansar Allah al Awfiya, aiming to reduce attacks on US personnel ([Long War Journal](#)). In Mali, jihadi groups affiliated with Al Qaeda are encircling the capital Bamako, threatening the fragile regime with a major offensive that could reshape West Africa's map ([Long War Journal](#)).

China's military transformation from commercial technology to combat power signals a growing strategic threat. Analysts have proposed a three-step plan to decisively counter Tehran's Islamist regime, which utilizes AI propaganda and opaque leadership tactics ([FDD](#) ; [FDD](#)). Additionally, a stabbing attack in London targeting Jewish men has been claimed by the Iran-linked group Ashab al Yamin, highlighting ongoing security challenges in Europe ([Long War Journal](#)).



Concerns have also emerged regarding a Gaza-based charity founded by a Hamas operative killed in the recent conflict, which continues to solicit funds through a US platform, raising questions about the financing of militant activities ([Long War Journal](#)).

Global Macro & Geopolitics

Modi's BJP victory in West Bengal not only reshapes state politics but also influences the party's national trajectory, signaling a consolidation of power in India ([BBC News](#)). Meanwhile, Nigeria plans to repatriate nationals from South Africa amid violent anti-migrant protests, underscoring ongoing regional tensions in Africa ([BBC News](#)).

Photographer Peter van Agtmael's new book draws stark connections between America's overseas wars and their domestic impacts, offering a profound perspective on the costs of conflict ([France24](#)). In Lebanon, Hezbollah's deployment of hard-to-jam fiber optic drones marks a tactical shift in ongoing clashes with Israel, despite a fragile ceasefire brokered by the US ([France24](#)).

In the South China Sea, a Philippine lawmaker's symbolic planting of the national flag on a disputed sandbar underscores ongoing territorial tensions amid a heavy Chinese presence ([The Diplomat](#)). Japan and Vietnam have agreed to enhance cooperation in energy and critical minerals, reinforcing their strategic partnership within the "Free and Open Indo-Pacific" framework ([The Diplomat](#)).

Pestilence & Global Health

Scientists warn that free-living amoebae, resilient to heat and disinfectants, are spreading globally due to warming temperatures and outdated water systems, posing serious health risks and complicating efforts to control microbes ([ScienceDaily](#)). An ancient mass grave in Jordan reveals how the Plague of Justinian rapidly devastated communities 1,500 years ago, illustrating how pandemics reshape societies far beyond the transmission of disease ([ScienceDaily](#)).

Recent research has identified a hidden virus within a common gut bacterium linked to colorectal cancer, suggesting that bacterial-virus interactions may be key to understanding cancer risk and enabling earlier detection ([ScienceDaily](#)). Additionally, madecassic acid, a compound derived from a Korean herb used in skincare, shows promise in killing drug-resistant bacteria by targeting unique bacterial proteins, offering hope for new antibiotics ([ScienceDaily](#)).



Natural Disasters & Signs in the Heavens

Recent seismic activity includes a magnitude 2.2 earthquake near Hidden Valley Lake, California, and a smaller magnitude 0.5 quake near The Geysers, California, reflecting ongoing tectonic activity in the region ([USGS](#); [USGS](#)). Similarly, a 2.2-magnitude quake struck near Salcha, Alaska, indicating active seismicity in multiple US regions ([USGS](#)).

NASA announced the retirement of Janet Petro, director of the Kennedy Space Center, marking a leadership transition at the agency ([NASA](#)). The Artemis II crew recently rang the Nasdaq closing bell, symbolizing the mission's milestone and NASA's ongoing exploration efforts ([NASA](#)).

Weather forecasts predict severe spring thunderstorms, excessive rainfall, and early snow, emphasizing the need for preparedness amid volatile conditions ([weather.gov](#)).

Middle Eastern Artifacts

Recent archaeological efforts in Jerusalem uncovered significant finds during a salvage excavation on Mishmar Ha-Gvul Street, led by the Israel Antiquities Authority and funded by Meshi Y. K. Construction and Development Ltd., as part of urban renewal projects ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#)). Excavations at Tel Qedesh have clarified stratigraphy and revealed Early Bronze Age mudbrick walls, deepening understanding of ancient settlement patterns ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#)).

Additional discoveries include a massive statue believed to represent Ramses II and a rare Roman-era Egyptian stela, as well as a well-preserved statue of Athena from Laodicea's Western Theater, illustrating the rich cultural tapestry of the region ([BiblePlaces](#)). A newly conserved Second Temple period ritual bath at Tel Hebron has opened to the public, while multispectral imaging has recovered 6th-century manuscript pages of Paul's letters, enhancing biblical scholarship ([BiblePlaces](#)).

Salvage excavations at Tel Zeror ahead of electric pole installations uncovered Middle and Late Bronze Age pottery, while two Roman-period burial caves near Tel Qedesh provide further insights into ancient funerary practices ([Israel Antiquities Authority](#); [Israel Antiquities Authority](#)).
